Nairobi Framework - Objectives

- Announced at COP/MOP2 by the UN Secretary General
- Partners: **UNFCCC, UNDP, UNEP, UNCTAD, UNITAR, WB, AfDB, UNECA**

Focus of the Framework:

- Build capacity in developing CDM project activities
- Build and enhance capacity of CDM DNAs to become fully operational
- Promote investment opportunities for projects
- Improve information sharing / outreach / education and training
- Inter-agency coordination

Table 1: Countries with fewer than 10 registered CDM projects as of 18th May 2010

Benefits of the Nairobi Framework

- **Better coordinated** efforts among the UN agencies and collaborating partners
- Forum for partners to regularly exchange information and experiences
- **Less duplication of efforts** to provide assistance on capacity building initiatives in developing CDM project activities
- **Coordinated efforts to mobilize resources for activities**
- Coordinated initiatives under the NF to **enhance capacity of the CDM DNAs**
- **Raising awareness** on CDM in general



Capacity building in developing CDM projects

- Partners involved: **UNEP, UNDP,UNITAR, AfDB**
- **Targeted regions:** Africa, Latin America and Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific
- **Overview of project activities or support:**
- Technical assistance provided to build capacity in project identification, design and implementation
- Strengthening the institutional and technical capacities of DNAs
- CDM cycle training workshops - developing PDDs, PoA development, SD criteria, project review and approval process



Build and enhance capacity of CDM DNAs

- **Targeted regions:** Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific
- **Overview of project activities or support:**
- Organizing DNA Forums to facilitate exchange of experiences and lesson learned
- DNAs provided training on CDM cycle
- Assistance to operationalise DNAs
- E-learning for DNAs on CDM cycle (Portuguese speaking countries)



Promote investment opportunities for CDM projects

- Partners involved: **UNFCCC, UNEP, UNDP, UNCTAD, WB, AfDB**
- **Targeted regions:** Africa, Latin America and Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific
- **Overview of project activities:**
 - CDM Bazaar – on-line platform for buyers, sellers and service providers
 - Developing CDM projects through MDG Carbon Facility
 - Developing case studies on CDM potential in countries with less than 10 CDM projects
 - Offering innovative ways for collaboration with African financial institutions and local project developers - ACAD
 - Carbon Finance Capacity Building (CFDB) programme – cities to reduce emissions
 - Organizing regional carbon forums



Improve information sharing, outreach, exchange of views, education and training

- Partners involved: **UNFCCC, UNEP, UNDP, UNCTAD, WB,**
- **Targeted regions:** Africa, Latin America and Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific
- **Overview of project activities:**
- Providing information on CDM process to DNAs, including training
- Developing information products and tools: CDM investor guide, methodology selection tool, brochures, publications
- Establishing Knowledge management and information platforms to exchange information and learn about CDM
- Developing e-learning programme on carbon finance for urban areas
- Organising CDM stakeholders workshops and promoting regional dialogue
- South-south cooperation and exchange of experiences
