



REVIEW OF THE PROJECT ACTIVITY

“Biomass based Hot Air Generation at Fertilizer Unit of Tata Chemicals Ltd., Haldia, West Bengal” (1890)

At its forty-fifth meeting the Board could not register the project activity “Biomass based Hot Air Generation at Fertilizer Unit of Tata Chemicals Ltd., Haldia, West Bengal” (1890) submitted for registration by the DOE (DNV) because the DOE and project participant failed to substantiate:

- (i) the selection of the baseline scenario, in particular that the unit cost of energy assumed represented market prices when the investment decision was made, or that real actions were taken to switch from furnace oil to coal fired HAGs; and
- (ii) the baseline emissions calculations, in particular that the assumed NCVs (both for coal and biomass) in the emission reductions calculations are appropriate.
