



Written Approval for Jepirachi Wind Power Project

To whom it may concern,

The Republic of Finland, acting through the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland in its capacity as the Designated National Authority for Finland under the Kyoto Protocol and paragraph 29 of the Modalities and procedures for a clean development mechanism annexed to Decision 17/CP.7 of the Marrakesh Accords, hereby declares that:

- (i) Finland ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 31 May 2002;
- (ii) Finland participates voluntarily in the Clean Development Mechanism;
- (iii) in accordance with the guidance issued by the Executive Board contained in the CDM glossary of terms, Finland hereby approves and authorizes the voluntary participation of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development as Trustee of the Prototype Carbon Fund ("PCF")¹ as a project participant in the Jepirachi Wind Power Project project activity (the "Project Activity");
- (iv) Finland recognises that the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, as Trustee for the PCF, is the focal point for the Project Activity with respect to all communications with the Executive Board and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
