

The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs acting as the UK's DNA confirms that:


1. the United Kingdom ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 31st May 2002;

3. to the extent that what is mentioned in paragraphs 1 and may constitute authorisation of EDF Trading Ltd's participation in the above named CDM project activity, and to the extent that such authorisation is required, this letter may be taken to constitute that authorisation.

In granting authorisation, the UK's DNA has not considered those matters that fall within the competence of:

- India as Host Party in respect of this project;
- SGS United Kingdom Limited appointed by the project participants as Designated Operational Entity in respect of this project; or
- the CDM Executive Board.

The UK does not intend to issue instructions in respect of, or to participate in the request for issuance of Certified Emission Reductions (CERs).
