PREAMBLE

Whereas:

- A. Sweden has ratified the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on May 31, 2002.
- B. The Swedish Energy Agency has been appointed Designated National Authority for the Clean Development Mechanism.
- C. Alternative Energy Promotion Centre, Nepal (AEPC) Household Maiya Gautam and Household Suk Man Tamang ("Project Entities") own and are implementing the Biogas Support Program - Nepal (BSP-Nepal) Activity-1 ("The Project") which aims at displacing fossil fuel by utilisation of biogas for cooking.
- D. The Project Entity and Göteborg Energi ("The Purchaser") through participation in the Community Development Carbon Fund have agreed to the sale and purchase of certified emission reductions generated by the Project.

NOW THEREFORE the undersigned as legal and authorized representative of the Government of Sweden declares that:

DECLARATION:

1. Sweden *approves* the Project as a Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) project in accordance with Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures thereunder and confirms that the participation in the Project is voluntary.
2. Sweden *authorizes* the Purchaser to participate in the Project activity in accordance with the Kyoto Protocol, the Marrakech Accords and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures thereunder.
3. Sweden *confirms* that public funding is not used for the purchase of Certified Emission Reductions from the Project.
