

Call for public inputs on Programme of Activites (PoA)

Questions

The following questions are mainly based on the guidelines and definitions of the EB 32 report, Annex 38:

- Point 2: "The physical boundary of a PoA may extend to more than one country provided that each participating non-annex I host Party provides confirmation that the PoA, and thereby all CPAs, assists it in achieving sustainable development."
 - <u>Question</u>: Is it possible to add additional host countries AFTER registration of the PoA? Or do all the LoA need to be obtained before registration, e.g. all countries that will be included in the PoA have to be defined in advance?
- 2. <u>Point 7</u>: "All CPAs of a PoA shall apply the same approved baseline and monitoring methodology, involving one type of technology or set of interrelated measures in the same type of facility/installation/land."

Questions:

2.1 How strict is "one type of technology" to be defined, can all small scale runof-river Hydropower Projects enter a PoA or only those with the very same technology (e.g. Pelton turbine low-head 2 MW)?
