Dear Mr. Morrison,

Thank you for your letter dated 22 November 2011, which was made available to the CDM Executive Board upon receipt.

Your case was discussed at the sixty-fifth meeting of the Board and as reflected in the meeting report (para 67)¹, the Board agreed to renew the crediting period for another seven years from 1 January 2010 until 31 December 2016. You may wish to note that the Board welcomed your statement to voluntarily undertake to request a revision of the monitoring plan for the project so as to be consistent with a revised version of the methodology AM0001 that has a lower w-factor, from the date of adoption by the Board of the revised methodology. You may wish to further note that the Board revised the methodology AM0001 at its sixty-fifth meeting (para 86 (a)).

In accordance with the instructions from the Board your letter has been made publicly available on the UNFCCC CDM website, as will this response.

I trust that this response adequately addresses the issues raised in your letter.
