PROCEDURES FOR APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF MULTIPLE METHODOLOGIES TO A PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES

(version 01)

A. Background

- 1. Paragraph 4 (f) of the "Procedures for registration of a programme of activities as a single CDM project activity and issuance of certified emission reductions for a programme of activities" provides for application of more than one approved methodology to each CPA involved into a programme of activities.
- 2. When validating a PoA which seeks to apply a combination of methodologies, the DOE shall submit a request for approval of the application of multiple methodologies in accordance with this procedure prior to the submission of a request for registration.

B. Request for approval of the application of multiple methodologies

- 3. The DOE shall submit a request for approval to the secretariat together with the latest version of the CDM-POA-DD and CDM-CPA-DD.
- 4. The secretariat shall evaluate the request for approval and place it on the agenda of the next meeting of the relevant Panel or Working Group, if the request has been received and considered complete four weeks prior to the start of the meeting of the relevant Panel or Working Group.
- 5. The Panel or Working Group shall evaluate the request to determine whether the applied combination of methodologies will be sufficient to address all project emissions and leakages that may occur as a result of the implementation of the CPA.
- 6. If the Panel or Working Group considers the combination to be sufficient, the request shall be recommended for approval by the Board.
- 7. If the Panel or Working Group does not consider the combination to be sufficient, the request shall be rejected and the coordinating/managing entity shall be recommended to submit a request for new methodology or a revision to an existing methodology to ensure such issues are addressed.
- 8. The secretariat shall make the recommendation of the Panel or Working Group publicly available, and forward it to the Executive Board for final decision.
