



VOLUNTARY CANCELLATION CERTIFICATE

Presented to:

CDM Project 4776: Run-of-the-river Hydroelectric Power Project in Uttarakhand by Alaknanda Hydro Power Company Limited.

Reason for cancellation:

GMR Hyderabad International Airport Ltd (GHIAL) is responsible for operation, management and development of Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA), Shamshabad, India. GHIAL is fully committed for climate change mitigation and to ensure sustainable development of RGIA. Since 2012, RGIA has been participating in Airports Council International's (ACI) Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme for greenhouse gas emissions management. RGIA achieved "Level 2 : Reduction" in 2012, and Level 3 : Optimization in 2013 under this Programme. In continuation of this journey, GHIAL has aimed towards Level3+: Neutrality by offsetting its scope 1, 2 and scope 3 (employees business travel) emissions. As part of this approach, GHIAL commissioned a 5 MWp solar power plant in 2015 and another 5 MWp in 2021 (total 10MWp) and started offsetting of its carbon emissions. And also purchased CERs for offsetting of the residual emissions. Consequently, GMR Hyderabad International Airport Ltd achieved ACI- Level 3+: Neutrality of the Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) in 2016. In 2020, GHIAL's Level 3+ accreditation was renewed for 3 years. GHIAL sustains Level 3+ status by offsetting its Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (employee business travel) emissions for the year 2020 by purchasing 18749 Certified Emission Reductions (equivalent to 18749 tons of CO2).
