1. The registered monitoring plan stipulates that the grid emission factor needs to be monitored "yearly after registration" however, neither the monitoring report nor the verification report indicates how this requirement has been met.		
2. The DOE has not provided sufficient information on the outcome of FAR 1 & 2 raised in the previous monitoring period related to emission reductions, calibration, personnel responsibilities, commercial invoices for electricity sales, QA procedures, emergencies, preparation of monitoring report, etc.		
3. The project activity is claiming zero project emissions in the monitoring report since it is indicated in the PDD that no fossil fuel will be consumed. However, it is unclear from the verification report how the DOE has verified that no fossil fuel has been consumed and thus confirming zero project emissions. Although the monitoring plan does not specify the requirement for monitoring of the fossil fuel used within the project boundary, the monitoring methodology applied to this project activity stipulates this requirement.
