
Swine Weight Measurement Operation in Pulau Island

Swine raised in Pulau Island is classified by age as follows.

- > Boar: Approx. 230 days (34 weeks) 5 years
- Saw: Approx. 230 days (34 weeks) 5 years
- ➢ Gilt: Approx. 160 − 230 days
- Porker: Approx. 70 160 days
- ➢ Weaner: Approx. 24 − 70 days
- Piglet: Approx. 0 24 days

Weight of each group is measured at the end of each growing stage as shown in the figure below.



As weight measurement is implemented when swine move into higher growing stage (ending weight), it is reasonable to use average of the ending weights for each category of swine as shown below.

- > Weight of Boar/ Saw: Average of D and E
- > Weight of Gilt: Average of C and D
- Weight of Porker: Average of B and C
- > Weight of Weaner: Average of A and B
- > Weight of Piglet: Average of general weight of piglet at birth (1.5kg) and A
