Response to request for review Optimization of steam consumption by applying retrofit measures in blow heat recovery system (Project 0677)

Dear Members of the CDM Executive Board,

We refer to the requests for review raised by three Board members concerning request for issuance of the CERs for project activity 0677 "Optimization of steam consumption by applying retrofit measures in blow heat recovery system" and would like to provide the following response to the issues raised by the requests for review inline with the response drafted by SGS.

## Comment: -

The DOE shall clarify on how it has verified that the methodological requirement of daily calculation of emission reductions, steam savings and the specific steam consumption after eliminating the data for those batch/shifts when production is beyond  $\pm$  5% of the nameplate capacity has been met.

## Response

We have acknowledged the clarification requested by the UNFCCC Executive Board and have modified the specific steam consumption calculation by considering shift wise production data of hot water and corresponding steam consumption which is within  $\pm$  5% range of the monthly average production. Therefore data points those which fall outside the  $\pm$  5% range of the monthly average production of hot water has been excluded from the calculation. Therefore, according to the latest modification in the calculation the emission reduction for the monitoring period 01/01/2007- 30/11/2007 stands as 15039 tCO<sub>2</sub>. For details on modification please find attached the revised spreadsheet "Final ER calculation 0677 BHRS 3rd Feb (final)" and the revised "Monitoring Report Version 04".

We sincerely hope that the Board accepts our aforementioned explanations.
