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**Minutes of the meeting taken by Secretary (Power) on
15.12.2005 to discuss the CDM projects in Power Sector**

A list of participants is annexed.

Initiating the discussions, Director (IC) said that though India has progressed well in number of projects under CDM, the projects from public sector and particularly in power sector are very few. To facilitate power sector projects under CDM, the Ministry had organized a workshop on 21.11.05 also. PMO has also drawn attention to the fact that more public sector projects should seek assistance from CDM.

Director, NTPC said that the company has already set up a group to take forward CDM projects. Projects for R&M of Badarpur Station and that of North Karanpura Power Plant are being prepared with technical assistance of GTZ and these are likely to be submitted to Designated National Authority (DNA) by April 2006. They are also looking for other R&M projects such as Singrauli Station.

NHPC informed that they are preparing CDM projects in respect of Nimo-Bajgo HE Project and Chutak Project with assistance of the World Bank. It was felt that NHPC could also pose Kotlibel HE Project for this purpose. Khab HE Project of SJVN would also be a suitable candidate in this regard. Chairman, BBMB informed that R&M project of Bhakhra Power Station is also being prepared for seeking CDM assistance.

ED, REC said that project of converting LT lines into HT lines in Andhra Pradesh with German assistance is being prepared for CDM assistance and would be posed to DNA by March 2006.

After discussions, following decisions were taken :

- a) PFC would provide necessary assistance to states and other agencies like DVC in seeking CDM assistance for projects of R&M of old generation plants.
- b) Similarly, REC would provide assistance to states for projects of LT to HT conversion and separation of agricultural feeders from household feeders.
- c) CEA would coordinate with and assist states in seeking CDM assistance to super critical thermal power plants. CEA would also prepare appropriate data for baseline determination both for new plants as well as R&M.

- d) NTPC, NHPC, PFC and REC would also take necessary steps for capacity building of employees which could be subsequently further enhanced through inter-organizational discussion.
- e) Ministry of Power would organize a workshop for the CPSUs under the Ministry of Power for discussing modalities for CDM projects with assistance of MOEF, World Bank, ADB and agencies like GTZ.
- f) Central sector power companies to take steps so that atleast 20 projects are posed to DNA by the end of March 2006.

In the meeting convened in PMO on 19.12.2005, CMDs of NTPC, NHPC, REC and PFC would participate.

Minutes ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
