# Extract of the resolution passed in the meeting of the Board of Directors dated 26.11.2004

The meeting has been called for discussing the issue of making investment in Wind Energy Generation. During the course of the meeting, the Managing Director of the company has put before the company for discussion and approval of the Board the offer letter received from M/s Enercon India Ltd and Vestas RRB India Ltd.

After the discussion at length along with the financials and the generation aspects of the both the offer letters it was concluded that the Enercon make machines have more advantages over Vestas make machines. However the idea of making investment in the Wind Energy is not a lucrative business for the reason of very low IRR. But one of the Director brought before the board that the Investment in Wind Energy sector is a viable proposition provided we consider the benefit of Carbon Emission Reductions. Based on these discussions the board has concluded as follows:

It was resolved " the company should make investment in Wind Energy Sector by making investment to the extent of 4.8 MW, consisting of 6 number Enercon Make E-48 Series Machines, after considering the benefit which will accrue on account of Carbon Emission Reductions."

**Further resolved** that Mr. H S Shetty, Managing Director of the company be and is hereby authorized to execute the decision of the Board by making proper purchase order in favour of M/s Enercon and also take necessary steps towards getting Carbon Emission Reduction benefits for the company".

#### Sub : Wind Power Project for installation at B.G. Halli.

This has reference to the meeting and discussion we had in our office today. As discussed and confirmed over the meeting, following transactions have taken place.

- It was agreed to place an order for 8 Machines of Enercon Make 800 WECs (Wind Energy Converters) developed jointly with M/s. Abletech Electro Engineers Pvt Ltd.
- 2. Enercon Scope : Foundation, supply, erection, commissioning upto D.P. Structure including step up 33 KV Transformer ( rating 950 KVA).
- MMCL Scope : Land, road, 33 KV line from D.P. Structure to sub-station, entire substation work, 66 KV over-head line, Bay extension, KPTCL work including evacuation permission, PPA inspection, approach road, permission etc to evacuate power from DP Structure until Horake Devanapura KPTCL 66/ Substation.
- 4. Enercon have agreed to give an absolute guarantee of Rs. 22.5 Lacs units per machine per year at 100% grid availability continuously for three years starting from one month after commissioning (on average basis).
- 5. Last date of commissioning is agreed as 20<sup>th</sup> May 2005.
- 6. Enercon will extend two years of free warranty and free O & M.
- Price agreed between both the parties is Rs. 350 lacs per machine as per agreed battery limits. This includes all taxes, tariff, transportation, erection, commissioning upto D.P. Structure.
- Enercon and MMCL shall enter into a comprehensive O & M and warranty contract for 8 years starting from expiry of the free warranty and O & M. The rate agreed is Rs. 4.5 Lacs per machine with 5% escalation per year
- 9. Payment terms: 25% advance, 65% after delivery of the material at site, 10% after successful commissioning.
- 10. On receipt of MOU, a token advance of Rs. 25 lacs will be paid and balance amount of advance will be released through bank immediately after sanction.

In acceptance of the above, please sign the duplicate and return the same to us.

In the meantime, kindly arrange to send us a draft MOU enable us to finalize the same at the earliest.

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#### **1** Proposal Motivation

The Clean Development Mechanism (CDM), is one of the three flexibility mechanisms under the Kyoto Protocol (KP), 1997 that enables developing countries to assist developed countries in meeting their green house gas (GHG) emissions reduction targets while the latter assists former in achieving sustainable development. Of proposed GHG abatement projects, those involving renewable energy (RE) are the most promising because they generate clean energy and promote sustainable development. The greenhouse gas benefits of each CDM project will be measured according to internationally agreed methods and will be quantified in standard units, to be known as 'Certified Emission Reductions' (CERs). These are expressed in tonnes of CO2 emission avoided (i.e 1 ton or 1000 kgs of CO2 is equivalent to one CER).

As the Kyoto Protocol came into force from 16th February 2005, these 'carbon credits' are bought and sold in a new environmental market and in fact, they have already become a commodity. Both the developing and the developed countries have so far shown increasing interest in developing such CDM projects in a most efficient and timely manner. The modalities and procedures for implementation of the CDM are also being streamlined, activities related to registration of several CDM projects and issuance of CERs for a few CDM projects have been already witnessed.

Mysore Mercantile Co.Ltd., and their associates have established a 9.6MW Grid connected Wind Turbine Generators in 2005. Wind Energy is a clean energy program eligible for Carbon Credits and, they have shown interest to develop this 9.6MW WTG under CDM. This project is located in Chitradurga, Karnataka.

Asia Carbon Emission Management India Pvt. Ltd., proposes to develop the CDM documentation for this project including the Project Design Document for

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validation and subsequent successful registration with the CDM Executive Board (CDM-EB) and management of carbon assets for successful transaction of CERs using the World's first CDM focused Asia Carbon Exchange.

## 2. Project Activity and Carbon reduction Potential

MMCL and their associates have established a 9.6MW Wind Turbine Generators, in the year 2005, with Enercon machines. Project is located in Chitradurga, Karnataka.

In the absence of the above project, state grid would depend on the power from fossil fuels, thus the project contributes to reduction of GHG. So the baseline is the grid.

Assuming a Grid Emission Factor of 0.75kg CO2/kwh, the Carbon Reduction potential of this activity is approx. 19600 tCO2 per annum or Carbon Revenue potential of 19600CERs annually.

#### **3** Objectives

The major objective of this proposal is,

" to develop the Project Design Documentation for validation and successful registration with the CDM Executive Board under the Clean Development Mechanism as defined in the Kyoto Protocol and facilitate sale of certified emission reductions generated from the project in the Asia Carbon Exchange."

#### 4. Scope of Work and Methodology

The scope of work and the methodology for developing the CDM project documentation are given below.

Activity I – Review of the project documentation

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Preparation of Project Design Document for validation by DOE (Designated Operation Entity) and registration with CDM-EB covering the following aspects as provided in the CDM-EB's PDD format :

The project design documents will be prepared as per the CDM EB approved PDD format for validation by Designated Operational Entity (DOE), host country approval and registration with CDM executive board (CDM-EB). The documents will cover the following aspects (as described in the CDM-EB approved PDD format) :

- Analysis of project activity including technological aspects
- GHG abatement details
- Methodologies :

\* If the baseline methodology proposed is new and does not fall under the approved categories of CDM-EB, the same will be submitted to CDM-EB for approval.

\* If the Monitoring and Verification methodology proposed is new and does not fall under the approved categories of CDM-EB, the same will be submitted to CDM-EB for approval.

- Justification of the baseline and monitoring methodologies chosen for the project
- Duration of the project activity and crediting period
- Environmental impacts of the project
- Stakeholder comments

#### **Baseline** estimation

The baseline for the Project will be determined in accordance with the provisions in the Kyoto Protocol, including the observations and guidelines developed by METH (Methodology) panel, as clarified from time to time.

The analysis and the outcome of the baseline study will feed as a major input for this activity for preparing the PDD as per the CDM EB format. Stakeholders' comments obtained during the site visits will also be analyzed and included in the PDD.

#### Monitoring and verification

For developing the methodology for monitoring and verification, the following factors will be considered.
