<p>The monitoring plan in the PDD stated that "Periodic calibration of all flow meters and totalisers will occur in accordance with industry standards." However, the project participant did not provide any calibration certificates. In response to that, the DOE accepted the project participant's proposal of deduction or addition of maximum inaccuracy corresponding specifications of the instruments from the values of the parameters. Further clarification on how the DOE accepted the proposal which is not in accordance with the registered monitoring plan is required.</p> <p>2. Further clarification on why the project participant did not provide the required monitoring parameter for the consumption of EFB from January to May 2006 is required.</p> <p>3. The DOE identified that the diesel consumption data was not in line with the meter reading and that the consumption in February 2006 was zero. However, the project participant's response to this NIR in the verification report is unclear. Further clarification on how the DOE accepted the project participant's claim regarding zero diesel consumption in February 2006 and the inconsistency of the meter reading is required.</p>
