Regarding the project that doesn't need to do the EIA report according to the Thai law, then, they must do the IEE report instead. This is a requirement for every PDD submission to the Thai government for acquiring an LoA. The CDM Project Reviewing Committee will look at the PDD together with the IEE report to find the information inside whether the project can pass the Sustainable Development Criteria for CDM projects. The new SD Criteria is published on ONEP's website, however, in Thai language.

A brief translation about indicators in the SD criteria can be found in the presentation attached.
