<p>Although the project participants claim that detail site specific data were presented to the DOE, the RIT member suggests presenting those data as an appendix to the monitoring report or the detailed calculation sheet should be made available to the RIT member and to the Secretariat. In the absence of detailed data, it is not feasible to check the calculation of GHG mitigation resulting from the project activity. At least the following data, which are listed in the monitoring report, must be provided by site:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Total animal population • Metered biogas flow • Measured CO₂ or Methane content <p>For the transparency purpose, biogas flared must be presented by site. Methane (or CO₂, as the biogas is assumed to contain methane and CO₂) contents of the biogas flared, and flaring efficiency should be presented by sites.</p> <p>The monitoring plan (Table 33, PDD, Table D.2.3.1) lists "Electricity production through captured methane" as one item to be monitored. Table B10 (Page 12) of the Monitoring Report also highlights this item (ID 19, Energy Production). Since the project activity considers only flaring of the captured methane, it is hard to understand why the electricity production is included in the list of items to be monitored and why it is also highlighted in the monitoring report.</p>
