- FarSter we request you to kindly renew the existing working capital facility.
- 4 Arthough we are satisfact in working related to banking with SBI but painfully regret to bring to the following lacts relating to higher interest being charged by State Bank of India or our Rupee loan.
 - (A) Presently SBI is charging interest of 12.25% pla on Term Loan A/a and @11,75% on Cash Orodit A/a (Rubbe Loan Portion) which is much higher than the rates of other commercial bank.
 - (B) Princeb National Bank and Bank of Baroda in our area are regularly sanctioning the Rupas Foat (\$9.9 to all the units in Shahjahanpur and offering us the Rupoc Loan (\$9.0% alongwith of foreign currency loans.)
 - (C) Since bog oning of the unit we are regular in making the repayment of principal and encered to the Book and have not committed default even for a single day in any account.

In view of the above and in this corapetitive business scenario we request your goodself to consider the reduction in rate of interest on D_{\bullet} (Rupee Loan) and Cash Credit Afo (Rupee Loan portion) to 9.0% p.e.

- 6. Further the processing charge and other charges like Bank draft charges etc. are also being the ged by State Bank of India are on very higher side. The following rate offer of Bank of Barada are being mortioned in Shanjahangur in their parties;
 - Concessing Fees: 50% of processing fees are being waived by the Bank of Baroda to decir parties and 50% are being charged from parties.

(ii) Only Charges The draft charges slabare

Oraft upto 1 00 Leo : 1,50% charged. Draft above 1,00 Leo : 1,90% charged.

State Bank of rod a was charging processing fees @Rs.2504 per Lac, and there is no waiver in the charges. We have also came to know that these rates have been enhanced w.e.f 1.10.04 to Rs.2804 Per Lac.

State Back of order two also charging draft charges of Rs 2.00 per thousand with a concession of 25% of these roles. Persently these charges have also been increased wielf 1.10.04 to Rs.2.50 per thousand

We therefore connectly request your goodself to kindly consider the reduction in processing charges and Back 0.25 charges to least level or equivalent to the rate being offered by Bank of Baroda in this ways.
