There was a short interruption in urea plant unit-21 due to failure of urea solution pump.</li> <li>Normal energy consumption per ton of urea has been 5.494MKCal/Te against P&amp;B of 5.310MKCal/Te.</li> <li>Average Gas drawl in the month was 1.361 MSM3/ Day (0.622 APM + 0.221 JV-PMT + 0.518 R-LNG) against allocation of 1.527 MSM3/Day while the average NCV was 8305.4 KCal/SM3.</li> <li>Naphtha contribution for the month was 0.5%.</li> </ul>	N C Bansal/ A K Gupta

3)	<b>Neem Coated Urea</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Presently IGF Neem coated urea production license is up to 8<sup>th</sup> July-2006, effort is being made for further extension of license.</li> <li>Matter for MRP of Neem Coated Urea is pending with DG-FAI and is being pursued regularly by Sr. V P (Marketing).</li> <li>Production plan of Neem Coated Urea for the month of July 2006 is 20000 MT.</li> <li>Neem Coated Urea should be dispatched first to strategic zone only as per planning.</li> </ul> <b>Zincated Urea</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The increment in yield with 1% Zn (coated with Zinc Sulphate) is 16-17% and the same for 2% Zn is around 20%. Thus 1% Zn is better and cost effective than 2% Zn. But we have to maintain 2% Zn to comply with FCO norms.</li> <li>Spray guns along with nozzles and fittings have already been received. Engineer from supplier visited to improve the spray pattern, nozzle is getting choked. Discussion with US suppliers under progress.</li> </ul> <b>Sulfonated Urea</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sample of sulphur coated urea having 1% sulphur content has been and handed over to marketing, their feed back is awaited and is expected after completion of the current crop season by end of April-2006.
