


Concession program had a significant infection on the wind power development in China. First, through the competitive bidding, the on-grid tariff that was in high level before had been decreased.







In the initial period (1985-1995), the main activity was to build small-scale testing demonstration wind farms by utilising grants from foreign donor countries and loans. Some European countries put their turbines into test in Chinese wind farms and accumulated a lot of experience in this period.

In the second period (1995-2003), on the basis of the initial period, the china government took some supporting measures to stimulate the wind farm development, such as "Bi- Emphasis", "national debt supporting", "Chengfeng plan".

In the third period (2003-now), the National Development & Reform Commission aimed to boost the wind industry by initiating a wind power concession program. As a result the wind industry in China has move into a rapid growth phase.
