

**GUIDANCE ON ELIGIBILITY OF PROJECT ACTIVITIES THAT PRODUCE PRODUCTS
WHOSE CONSUMPTION LEADS TO EMISSION REDUCTIONS****(Version 02)**

1. The Board in its thirty-fifth meeting (paragraph 22) clarified that project activities that result in emission reductions due to the use/consumption of a product produced in the project activity are only eligible as CDM project activity if: (i) the users/consumers of the product are included in the project boundary; and (ii) monitoring takes place of the actual use/consumption and location of the product used/consumed by consumers.
2. The Board further clarified that in such situations sampling can be used as a monitoring method for actual use/consumption and location of the product.
