



**Final Ruling Regarding the Request for Registration of
“Shanxi Hongyi Glassware Co., Ltd. Small-scale Fuel Switching Project” (4701)**

The CDM-Executive Board decided to reject the above proposed project activity on 25th November 2011, during its 65th meeting, in accordance with “*Procedures for review of requests for registration*”, version 1.2, EB 55, Annex 40, paragraphs 23, 24 and 28 (the procedures). In accordance with paragraph 27 of the procedures, the rulings shall contain an explanation of the reasons and rationale for the final decision, which are as follows:

- The DOE (DNV) failed to demonstrate that the project activity complies with paragraphs 8 and 22(a) of the applied methodology AMS III.B (version 14) as the heat output from the kilns has not been directly measured and monitored.
- Paragraphs 8 and 22(a) of the methodology AMS III.B (version 14) states that: “*This category is applicable to project activities where it is possible to directly measure and record the energy use/output (e.g., heat and electricity) and consumption (e.g., fossil fuel) within the project boundary*” and “*Monitoring shall include: (a) Monitoring of the fossil fuel use (FCy) and output of element process i after the project activity has been implemented (QPJ,y) - e.g., gas use and heat output by a district heating plant, gas use and electricity generated by a generating unit*”.
- However, the monitored parameter mentioned in the validation report (section 4.7.3) is the “production of glassware (in tonnes) in year y” without any further reference to the direct measurements of the energy use/output (e.g., heat and electricity) within the project boundary.
- The alternative approach to measure and monitor the heat output from the kilns is not in line with the applied methodology, which requires direct measurement and recording of the energy use/output within the project boundary.

Please note, however, that, with appropriate revisions, this project activity may be resubmitted for validation and registration provided it meets the requirements for validation and registration, in accordance with paragraph 42 of the CDM Modalities and Procedures (Decision 3/CMP.1).
