Christiana Figueres, the UNFCCC Executive Secretary, is a leader in the global climate change field and a former member of the CDM Executive Board. A native of Costa Rica, she has been an official negotiator of the UNFCCC and Kyoto Protocol since 1995. In 2008, she was elected Vice President of the Bureau of the Conference of the Parties.
