The new crediting period shall start on the day immediately after the expiration of the current crediting period regardless of the date the project participants have submitted the renewal of crediting period request form and the date the current crediting period is deemed renewed in accordance with paragraphs 266 and 279, respectively. Project Participants shall be allowed to claim CERs from the first calendar day of the renewed crediting period.	
2	266	5	te	Remove the step of submitting renewal intention and abolishing the creation of "unclaimable period".	The project participants wishing to renew the crediting period of a registered CDM project activity shall submit through a dedicated DOE the completed "Renewal of crediting period request form" (CDM-REN-FORM) and an updated PDD to the secretariat by e-mail or through a dedicated interface on the UNFCCC CDM website, not earlier than 270 calendar days prior to the date of expiration of the current crediting period. The secretariat shall make every effort to inform the project participants 270 calendar days in advance of the end of the current crediting period about the possibility to renew the crediting period in accordance with the registered modalities of communication. It remains the responsibility of project participants to ensure that all actions are taken in accordance with the current section of this procedure in a timely manner.
