¿Qué es la cancelación voluntaria de RCE?

La cancelación voluntaria permite a los participantes de proyectos de MDL que mantienen sus RCE en el Registro MDL cancelar las reducciones certificadas que se encuentren a su nombre o a nombre de terceros.

El procedimiento para la cancelación voluntaria de RCEs fue aprobado por la Junta Ejecutiva del MDL en la JE 69 de septiembre de 2012.



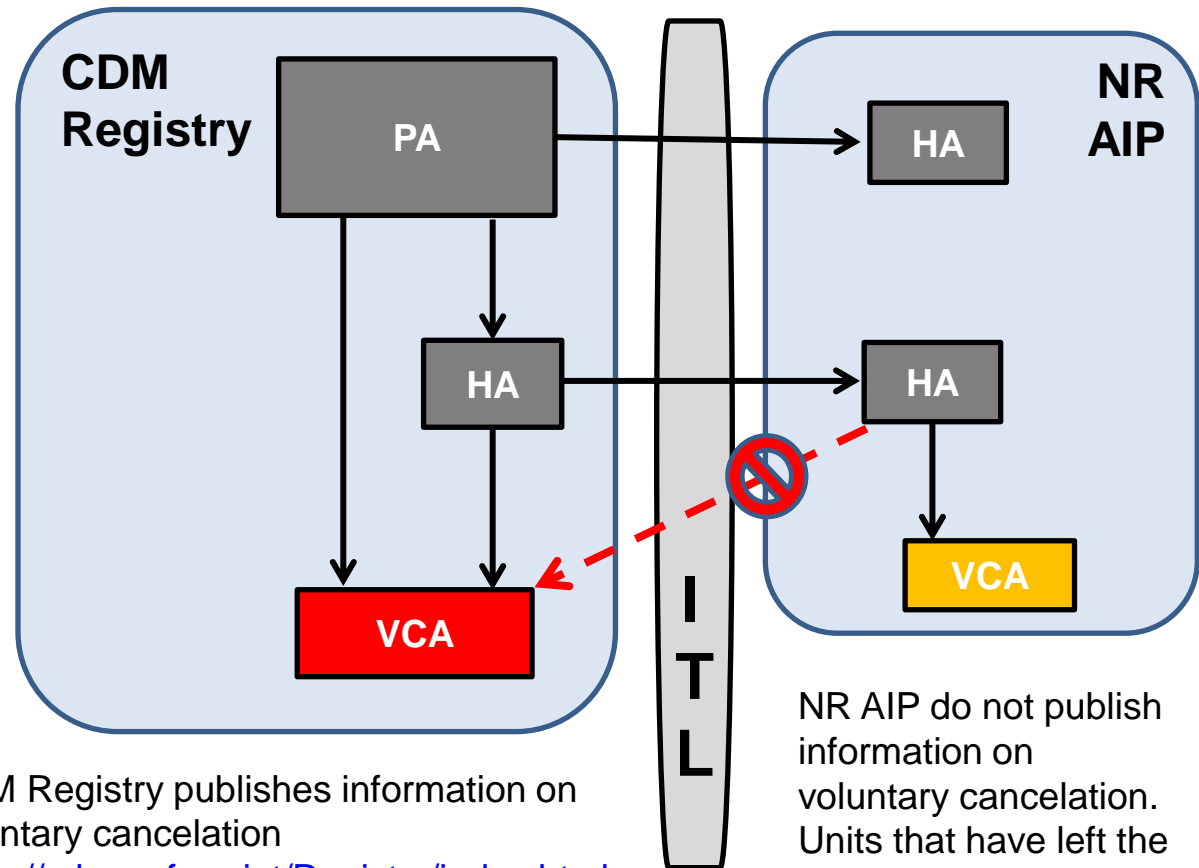


Voluntary Cancellation of CERs

CDM Registry is only open to non-AIP and their authorized PPs. Parties and PPs can have HA. They can hold only units from projects they participate in.

CDM Registry only:

- (1) forwards units from the PA to HA of PPs in the CDM Registry or in NR AIP; or
- (2) cancels units in the VCA.



CDM Registry publishes information on voluntary cancellation

NR AIP do not publish information on voluntary cancellation. Units that have left the CDM Registry can only be canceled in NR.AIP

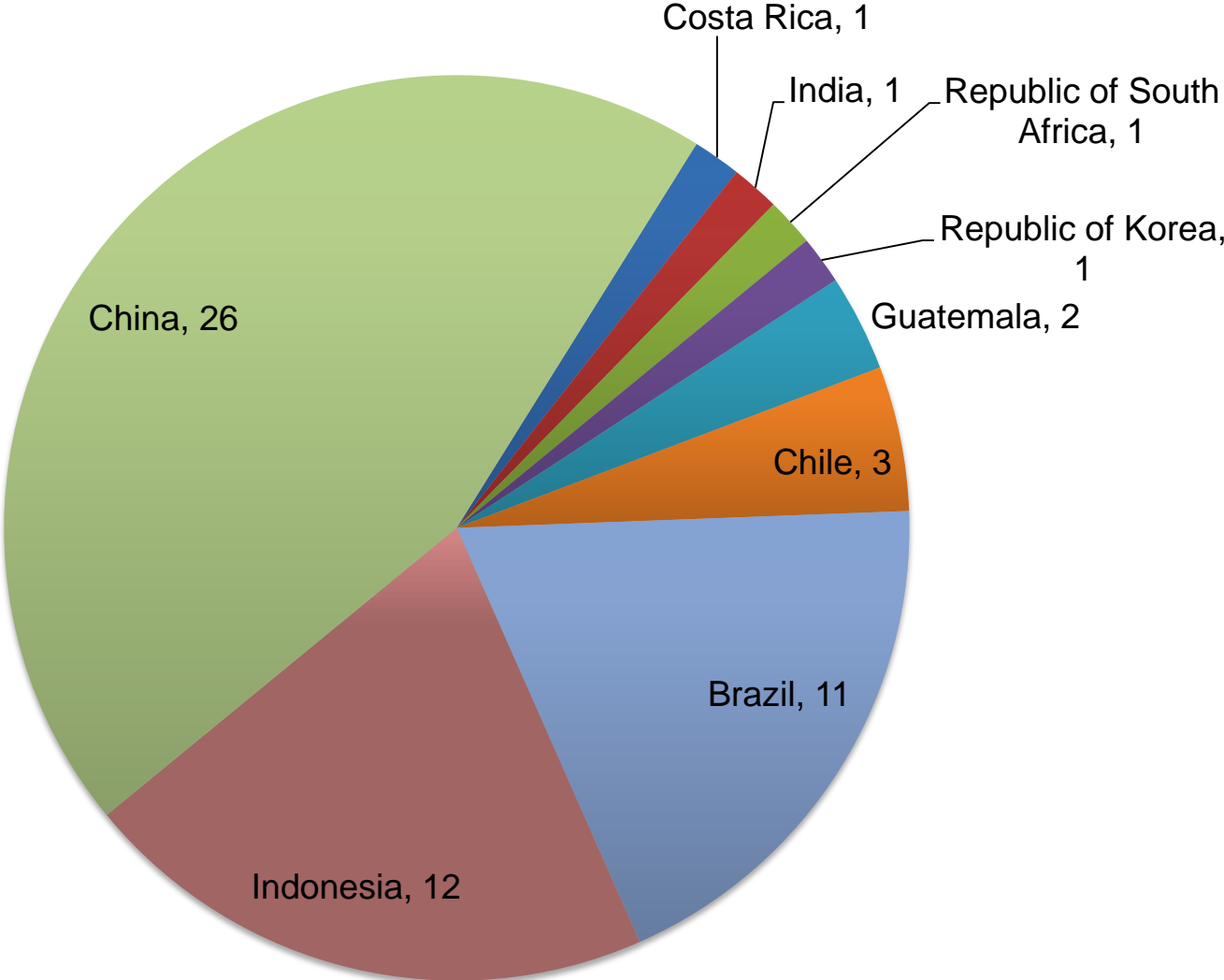

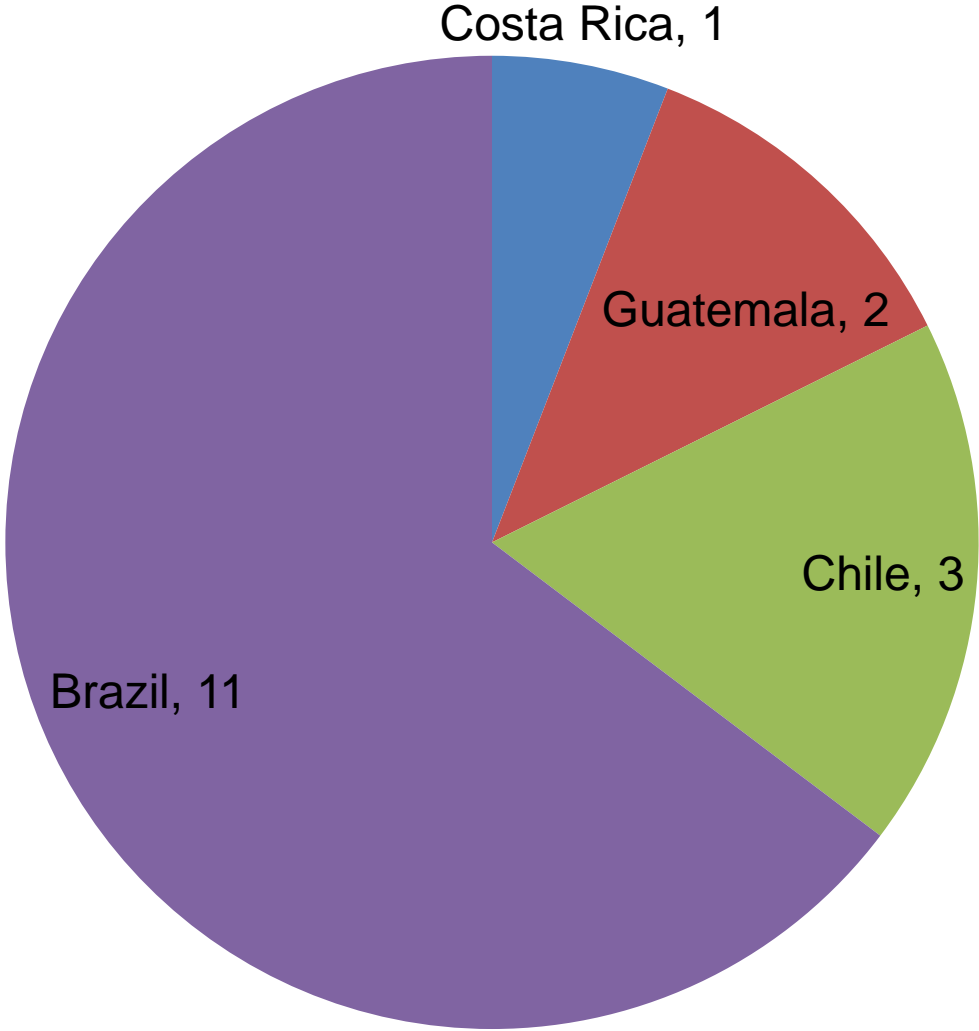

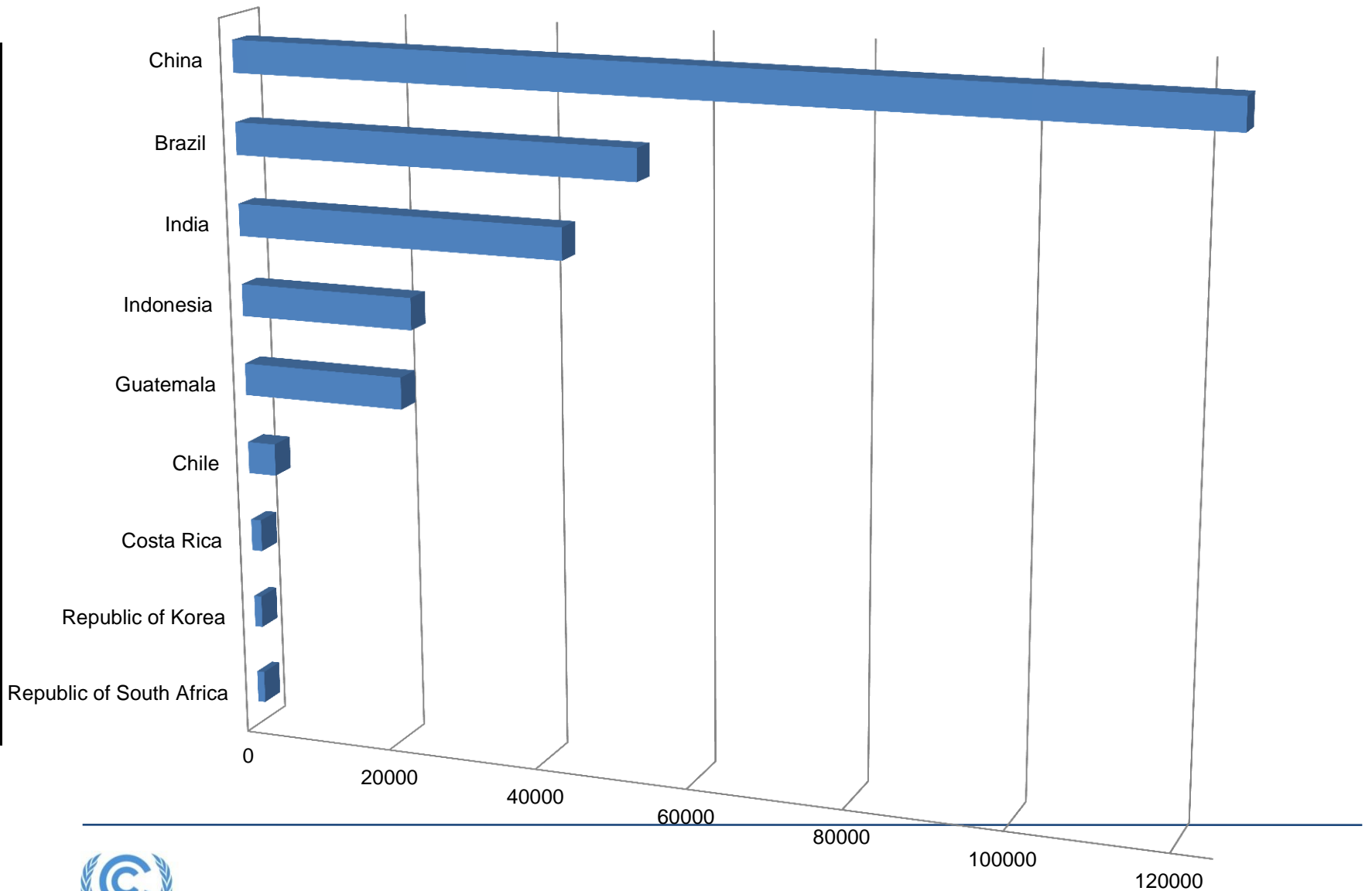
Número de proyectos MDL por país



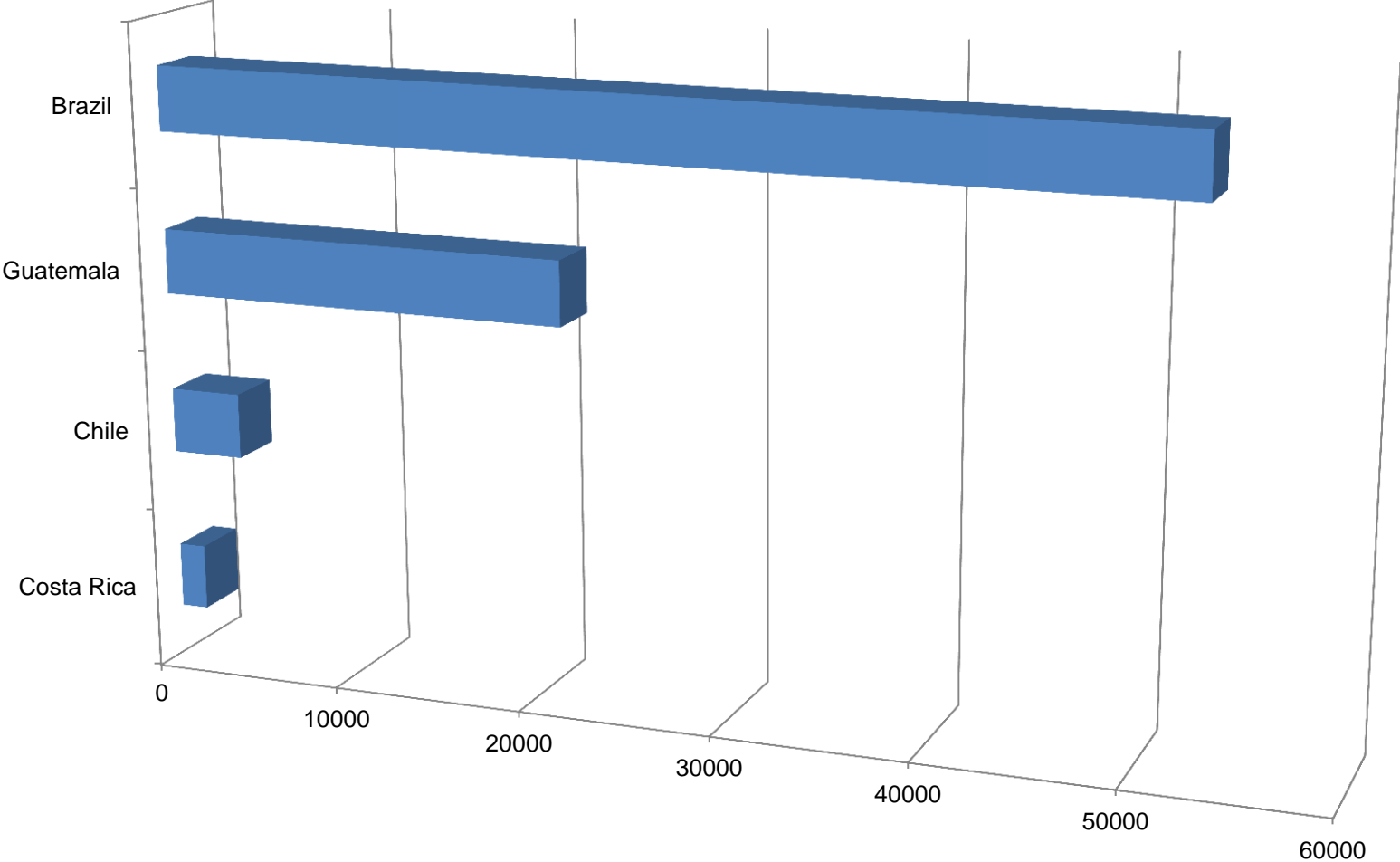
Número de proyectos MDL por país en América Latina



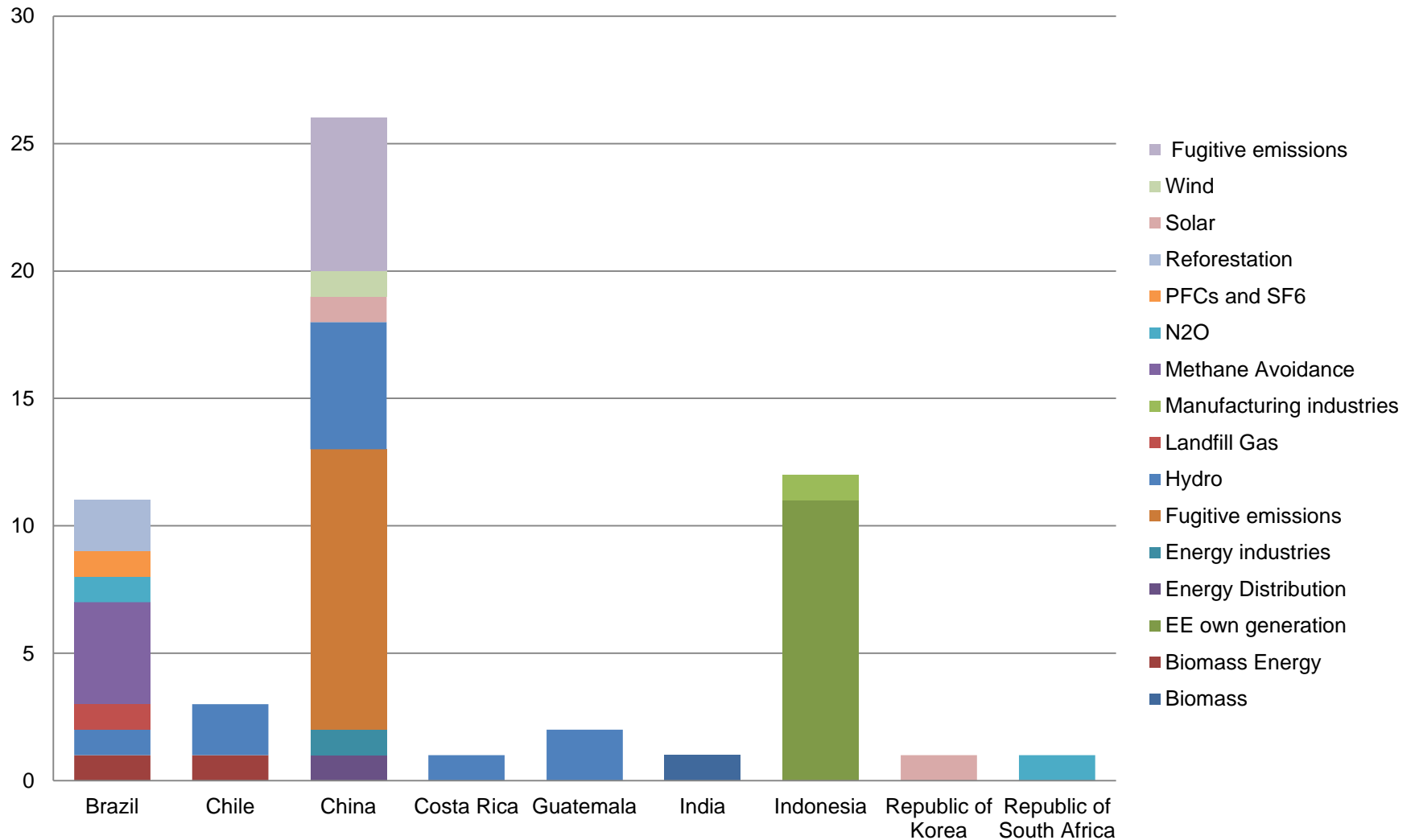
Volumen de CERs/tCERs cancelados por país



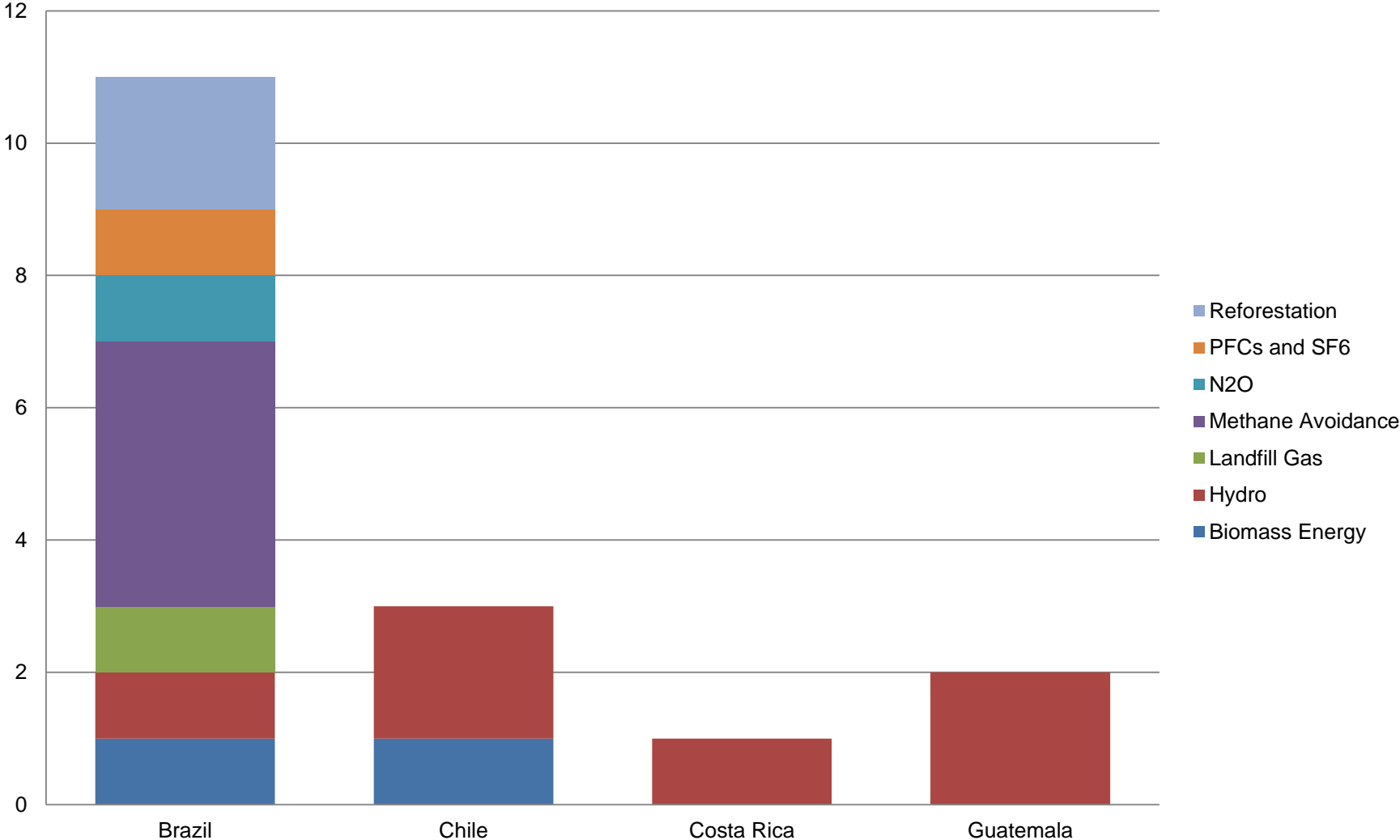
Volumen de CERs/tCERs cancelados por país en América Latina



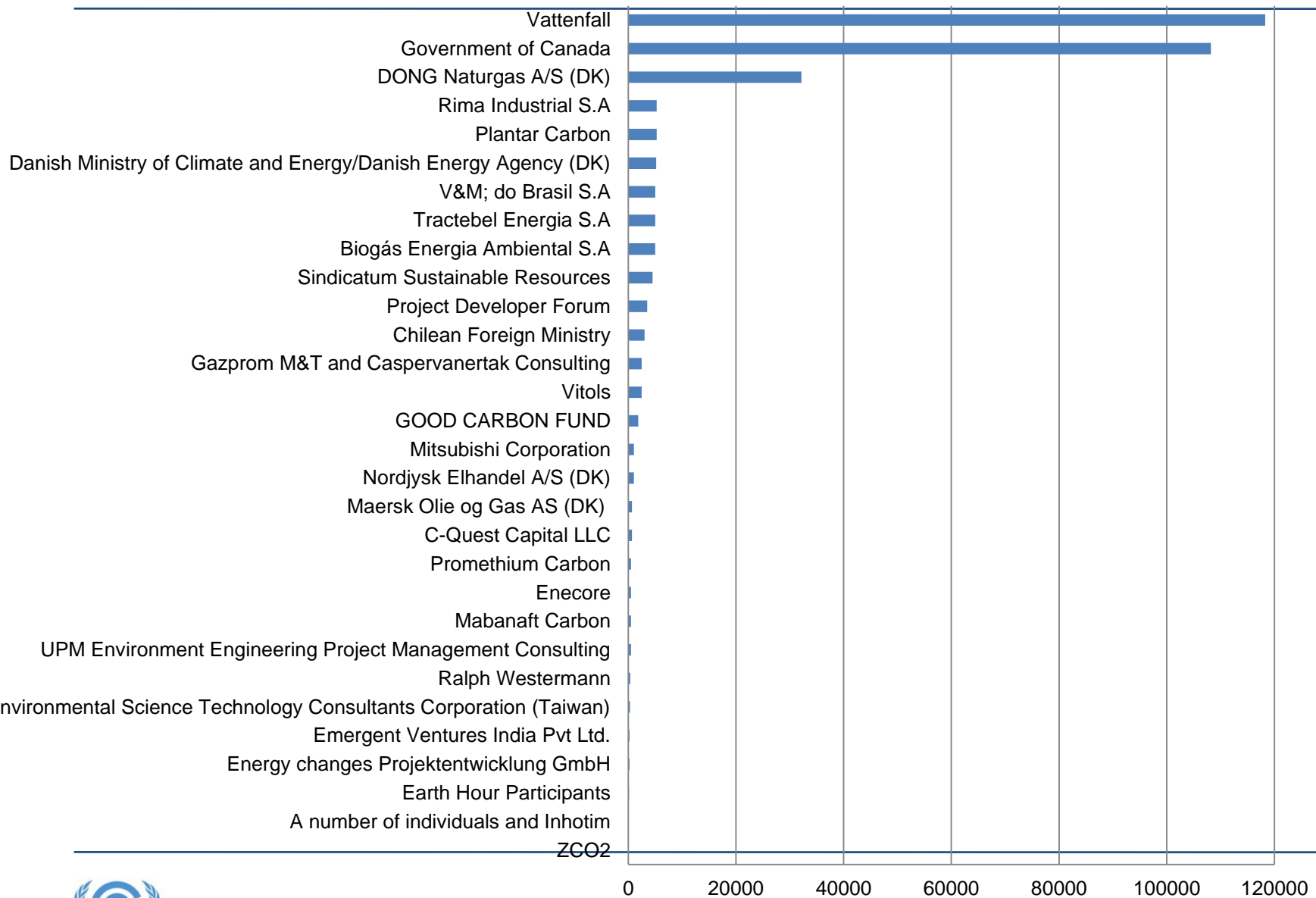
Número de proyectos MDL por país y tipo



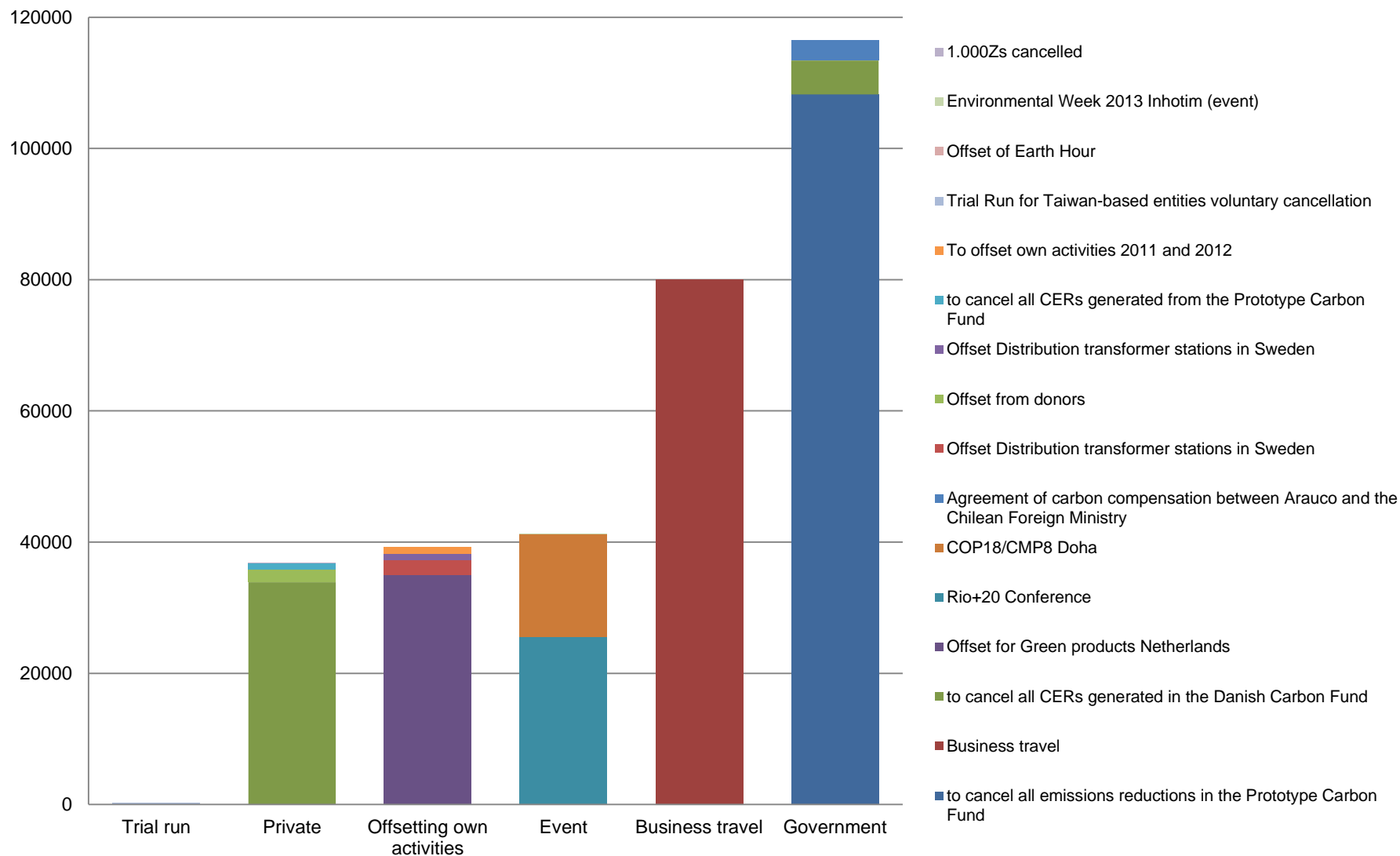
Número de proyectos MDL por país y tipo en América Latina

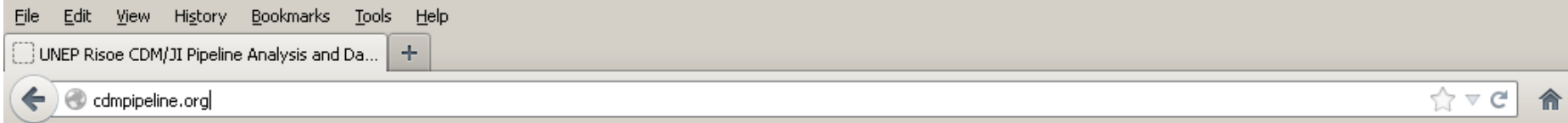


Volumen de CERs/tCERs cancelados por beneficiario

Institutional background

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol on its first session, held at Montreal from 28 November to 10 December 2005, established that the CDM Executive Board shall develop and maintain the CDM registry according to the requirements set out in *Appendix D to the report (FCCC/KP/CMP/2005/8/Add.1)*.

Voluntary Cancellation of CERs:

Voluntary cancellation allows project participants who hold certified emission reductions (CERs) in the CDM registry to cancel them on their own behalf or on behalf of third parties. This gives them access to a broader source of demand for CERs in the voluntary market, while making a diverse portfolio of credits available to organizations and individuals wishing to reduce their carbon footprint. Interested buyers can filter available CERs by country and/or project type to ensure that their purchases are in line with organizational goals or personal preferences.
