Background

- First PoA procedure adopted in June 2007 (EB32) version 1.
- Version 2 was adopted in October 2007 (EB 35)
 - Minor changes to clarify the role of a DOE in small-scale POAs
- Version 3 was adopted in May 2009 (EB 47)
 - This was a more significant overhaul of the applicable procedures
 - Facilitated the application of more than one methodology
 - Relaxed the rules related to the start date of CPAs
 - Clarified the rules related to the review of erroneous inclusion of a CPA



Background

- At EB47: two new procedures adopted and one revised
 - Procedure for Registration and issuance (revised)
 - Procedure for Review of Erroneous Inclusion of a CPA
 - Procedure for Application of multiple methodologies
- Version 4 was adopted in July 2010 (EB 55)
 - Main changes related to addition of definitions, limits the number of focal points, includes procedures for change of CME, other miscellaneous clarifications.

CMP Mandate and Action plan

- <u>CMP.6, paragraph 4:</u> Requests Executive Board to <u>reassess its</u> <u>existing regulations</u> related to PoA in order to:
 - (a) Further <u>clarify</u> the application of existing rules:
 - demonstration of <u>additionality</u> to PoA
 - definition of eligibility criteria for the CPA inclusion in a PoA
 - (b) Simplify the application of PoA to activities :
 - Applying multiple methods and technologies
 - Possible <u>city-wide</u> programmes

Launch Call for Inputs from Stakeholders at EB59

- Executive Board, at its 59th meeting, agreed to launch a call for public inputs on programme of activities (PoA) from 18 February 2011 until 18 March 2011, to seek comments on issues associated with the development and scaling-up of PoAs as a CDM project activity and its difficulties. In addition to expressing views regarding the implementation of paragraph 4 of decision 3/CMP.6, the Board specially seeks for inputs, in the above context, on the following:
 - (a) What are the possible alternative concepts for a PoA?
 - (b) What are the barriers in the current rules?
 - (c) What are the rules that are not existing or are missing and should be there?
- A total of 19 inputs were received.


