CDM Policy Dialogue – report and recommendations

Main issues discussed:

- General support for large parts of the report's recommendations by most stakeholder groups
- Focus on positive messages e.g.
 - a) the CDM as one high-quality solution part of the wider market-based options of any future climate regime and
 - b) the availability of large volumes of emission reductions at low prices
- Look further at the underlying research once available (next week). Use that wealth of information widely and in a neutral form for communication.



CDM Policy Dialogue – report and recommendations

Main issues discussed:

- Suggestion for all stakeholders to come up with as concrete as possible action items emanating from the report's recommendations for the attention of
 - a) the CDM contact group,
 - b) the ministerial side event,
 - c) individual delegations
 - d) And the general press
- Use EB's Trust Fund to develop an outreach strategy and support other stakeholders' outreach strategies. Make sure the urgency and options are easily understood
- EB already working on some recommendations. Further work together with stakeholders on implementing these recommendations, e.g. LoA withdrawal or local SD monitoring, if addressed as part of a balanced consideration of all of the recommendations, could result in reaching more common ground than was possible in the past.
