Re.: Request for resubmission of a request for post-registration change in the start date of the crediting period


Dear Mr. Watanabe,

Thank you for your letter received on 28 October 2011, which has been available to the Chair of the Board.

On behalf of the Chair of the Board, I would like to inform you that it is noted the efforts made in order to implement the project activity "Angkor Bio Cogen Rice Husk Power Project"(Ref# 0363), in view of the several barriers faced in the host country of the project. The spirit of the revision of the Procedure for requesting post-registration changes to the start date of the crediting period, in particular the inclusion of paragraph 8 of the current version 2, was to allow requesting a change in the start date of the crediting period by more than two years but no more than four years for project activities hosted in Least Developed Countries with the aim of enhance regional distribution of the CDM.

Given the fact that this provision was not available at the time of submission of your previous request to change the start date of the crediting period of the aforementioned project activity and that the reasons for this second request are not because of incorrect planning of the project implementation but because of barriers faced during the development of the project and the only possibility back then to request for a two years delayed start date of the crediting period, on behalf of the Chair of the Board, I inform you that the requirement to only submit such a request once shall be waived for your request. In order to complete the necessary administrative process please submit your request in accordance with the above mentioned procedure.
