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<p>A project activity consisting of a 50-MW wind farm that is currently under validation with an expectation of becoming registered in the CDM before 31 December 2012, will be forced to be relocated due to technical reasons related with the power transmission lines, which make the original location not feasible. The decision on the relocation may be taken after the registration date, or the request for registration may be delayed with the risk of missing the objective of a crediting period starting in 2012.</p> <p>The project developer ensures the availability of information on winds and environmental impacts, and the relocation is not expected to affect the baseline or the additionality of the project.</p> <p>Carbosur would greatly appreciate the guidance of the Executive Board on the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Can the wind farm being relocated be considered as the same project activity if the relocation is decided after the registration date, or would it be necessary to start a new validation process, including the submission of a Prior Consideration of the CDM Form?</li> <li>2. In the case that the project activity being relocated is registered in 2012 and maintains its identity after its relocation, would a post-registration revision of the PDD suffice for introducing the changes in the location of the turbines, the expected power generation, the baseline scenario, the additionality assessment and the environmental impact assessment, without changing the registration date?</li> <li>3. The project activity is named after its current location. Would it be possible to change its name without affecting the maintenance of its identity?</li> </ol>
