**Re.: Delay in project activity implementation by 2 years 11 months**

Dear Mr. Agrawal,

Thank you for your letter received on 29 May 2012, which has been made available to the Chair of the Board.

On behalf of the Chair of the Board, I would like to inform you that, as per Annex 59 (para 7 (c)) of the report of the fifty-second meeting of the Board, if a designated operational entity (DOE) submits a confirmation to the secretariat that no changes have occurred, which would result in a less conservative baseline, and that substantive progress has been made by the project participants to start the project activity, the start date of the crediting period may be delayed by more than one year but no more than 2 years. In the case of project activity Ref. 1693, if the above mentioned confirmation is sent by a DOE, a request can be sent to delay the start date of the crediting period up to 31 May 2011.

I hope this letter suitably addresses all your concerns.
