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Honorable Members of the CDM Executive Board,

Dear Mr. Duan.

The current market price for CERs is extremely low: the spot price today is below EURO 0.20 per CER, the Dec-13 contract is below EURO 0.40 per CER. The registration and issuance fees therefore, at current market prices, make up a very large share of the market value of the reductions achieved through the CDM.

We understand that an issuance fee is required to pay for the continuing administration of the CDM. The registration fees were necessary in the early years of the CDM to finance the mechanism at a time when few issuances occurred. However, as the CDM has now built up a large financial reserve, the upfront registration fees should no longer be necessary.

Further, if CER prices remain low, the level of the issuance fee may also need to be re-considered in order for CDM projects to continue. Please note that we are not suggesting to remove the 2% adaptation fund contribution.

Therefore, the PD Forum would like to request that the EB consider our proposal to waive registration fees for all projects yet to be submitted for a period of 6 months, after which the EB may review the situation in light of market prices at this time.

Your consideration of this suggestion would be very welcome, and we would of course be available to discuss it further with you.
