Dear Ms. Trandem,

Thank you for your letter, received on 15 February 2013, which has been made available to the CDM Executive Board.

On behalf of the Chair of the Board, I would like to thank you for presenting your concerns regarding the CDM project activity 8761: Stung Tatay Hydroelectric Project.

Please note however that the proper channels for raising comments on a project before its submission for registration are (i) the local stakeholder consultation and (ii) the global stakeholder consultation. Substantiated comments which have not been taken into account through the aforementioned channels can nevertheless still be brought to the attention of the designated national authority (DNA). The DNA can request a review of requests for registration or issuance of any project located in its country within 28 days of their publication on the UNFCCC website¹. We would therefore like to encourage you to share your concerns with the host country DNA.

Finally, please note that only the host country's authorities have the prerogative to assess and enforce compliance with national laws. As a result, any legal action against project violating national laws must be undertaken at the national level.
