As per the GUIDELINES ON THE DEMONSTRATION AND ASSESSMENT OF PRIOR CONSIDERATION OF THE CDM, Version 04, Annex 13, EB 62, the project activity, which has started after 2nd August, 2008, PP is required to notify UNFCCC as well as DNA within six months from the start of the project activity about their intent to develop the project as a CDM project.

We, **Friends Group of Companies**, an Industrial House in India implemented a bundled wind power project of capacity 35.7 MW, which has been distributed under our various group companies.

As per the CDM glossary purchase orders placed to the wind turbine supplier for procuring the equipments is treated as "Start Date" of the project activity. We had placed the purchase orders for different group companies to the wind turbine supplier in a phased manner over a period of ten months. Though we had intimated to UNFCCC as well as DNA about the bundled project activity within six months from the date of placing the last purchase order but we had missed to intimate UNFCCC as well as DNA within six months of placing the first purchase order to the equipment supplier, which is treated as the start date of the project activity.

The details of the purchase orders placed, commissioning of the WTGs and stakeholder's consultation under different companies are provided as below.
