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The project PA 4820 (Wind Park at the Orites Archimandritas, Cyprus) has been registered on 17 May 2011, but did not have to pay the registration fee until first issuance due to less than 10 registered projects on Cyprus. As the project has been registered for 144 MW (174,990 CERS/yr), the deferred registration fee has been calculated as USD 33498,00. Due to several reasons up to now only 82 MW of the windpark has been realised and issuance has been requested for 47462 CERs in 2011 and expected request for issuance of 2012 is 75000 CERs. Total administrative share of proceeds for 2011 and 2012 is therefore 21492,00 USD.

Since Cyprus changed its Kyoto status to an Annex-1 country, the project might not be able to generate any CERs after 2012. Therefore, the project will not be able to refund the full registration fee.

Request now is to lower the registration fee to the share of proceeds based on the implemented 82 MW (average yearly CERS will be 99650, registration fee should be 18429,00 USD) or to reimburse the part of the registration fee which cannot be used for the administration share of proceeds for issuance of CERs.
