Dear Mr. Garcia Urrea,

On behalf of the Chair of the CDM Executive Board (the Board), I would like to thank you for your letter of 27 June 2013, communicating your request for the Board to provide clarification on the finding of “incompleteness” during the completeness check (CC) of project 9390 “San Nicolas CDM Reforestation Project”. Your letter has been made available to the Board.

As communicated to your designated operational entity (DOE), no formal reply to the original e-mail detailing the incompleteness issues was received by the secretariat. Furthermore, no evidence is available showing that a response e-mail (either with or without spreadsheet attachments) was sent to the secretariat’s e-mail system. The DOE has not responded adequately to the subsequent secretariat requests to forward such evidence. Therefore, in accordance with the CDM project cycle procedure (PCP), version 4.0 para. 62, the request for registration was deemed incomplete.

Finally, I would like to inform you that the appropriate channel for contacting the secretariat on issues related to the case-specific application of provisions contained in the PCP should be through e-mail to [Cdmregistration@unfccc.int](mailto:Cdmregistration@unfccc.int). The DOE is therefore encouraged to submit the full evidence as per the appropriate channel.
