- 1. Discuss how governments, including DNAs, and public entities can promote the use of the standardized baselines to support their development objectives;
- 2. Explain the "Guidelines for the establishment of sector specific standardized baselines" (Annex 8, EB62) and enhance the understanding, in a country with less than 10 CDM projects;
- 3. Receive advanced inputs to the work on developing the regulatory framework on standardized baselines by EB63, in line with the directions provided by the Board in its sixtieth meeting (para 39 / EB60), in particular to receive inputs on the draft Procedures for submission and assessment of standardized baselines¹; and
- 4. Initiate discussions on alternative approaches to support the future evolution of the guidelines with focus on new solutions for the standardized baseline development with more emphasis on the options for a way forward.
