## **Issues and Opportunities**

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## **SB Workshop – Issues & Barriers**

- Availability of required data with DNAs of the parties.
- □ More clarity on the time periods for which data need to be reported and criteria for documentation and verification of provided data is required.
- □ Further guideline on determination of baseline emission intensities for fuels and technologies is required.
- □ Appropriate guideline for establishing benchmarks made on emissions per output , where outputs have different qualities.
- □ Applicability of this guideline for retrofit projects is to be confirmed .
- $\Box$  Further clarity on calculation of the cost per unit of output in a standardised fashion where costing is plant or location specific.
- $\Box$  Needs guidance to DNAs for deciding on the levels of x and y is required. Further How frequently should these be revised?
- □ How the date confidentiality issue, if any, will be addressed.
- $\Box$  Further guideline for LDCs is required where no data is available or no capacity is available to regularly update the data sets used under the developed SB.



## **SB Workshop – Opportunities & Way Forward**

□ SB will help to improve CDM penetration in under represented countries with appropriate initiatives and help of secretariat

Guideline needs to include guidance on data collection procedure for DNAs needs to provide required technical (and if required financial) support to DNAs (LDCs) for data collection

□ Secretariat needs to invest on capacity development of the DNAs for new SB assessment and approval

Secretariat assistance is also required by DNAs for technical assessment of the SB submitted by the private / government project entity.
In view of high applicability, following potential sectors should be considered on high priority for SB development

- Waste Management Landfill and composting
- Grid based electricity generation (RE and FF based)
- Transport projects

□ Secretariat should develop SB on behalf of few parties, for at least couple of few most common project types
