Background

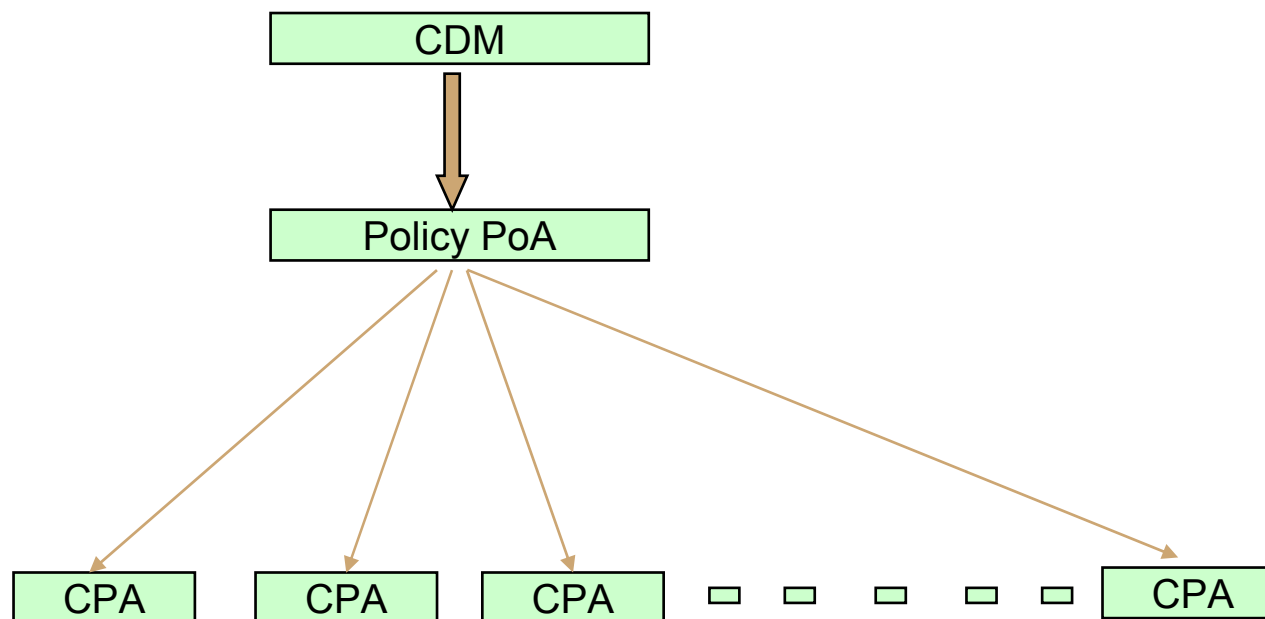
- CMP6 requested EB to reassess its existing regulations related to programmes of activities in order to further clarify the application of existing rules regarding the demonstration of additionality of programmes of activities
- A call for public inputs on programme of activities
- EB60 requested the secretariat to prepare a standard for the demonstration of additionality of a programme of activities
- PoA workshop (7-8 May 2011)



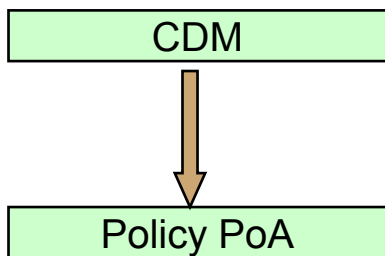
Definitions

- A policy
 - An expression of purpose that is indicative of a goal
 - A programme of action that has been decided on and oriented towards the same long-term policy objective for the reduction of GHG emissions
 - Written policy documentation shall be publicly available
- A policy PoA is a type of PoA that is generally undertaken by a public entity to:
 - Implement a new policy; or
 - Enforce an existing policy that is systematically not enforced; or
 - Achieve an enhanced implementation of an existing policy.
- A measure PoA is a PoA undertaken by a private or public entity to implement GHG emission reduction activities that are not policy driven.

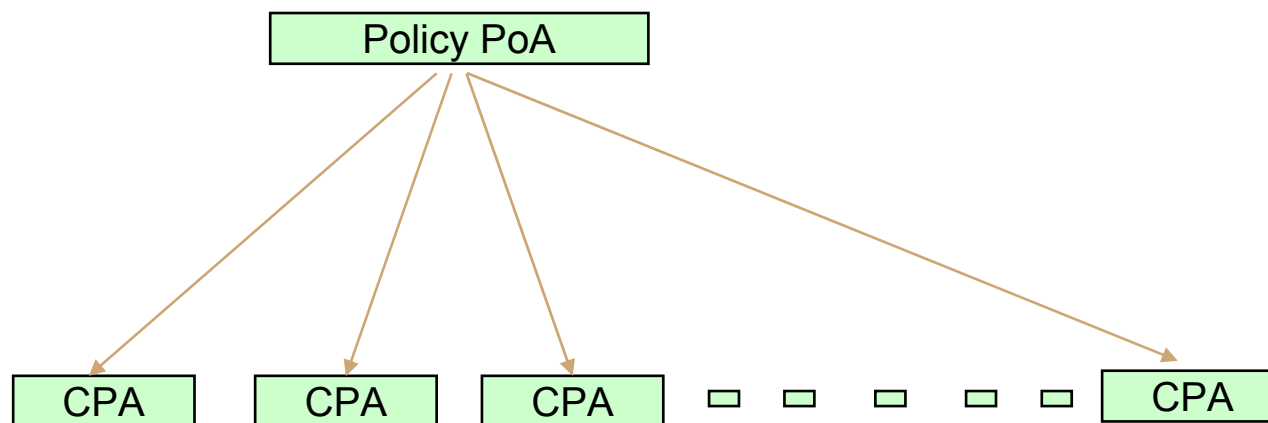


Policy PoAs



- IPCC policy assessment
 - Environmental effectivenessbut facing barriers in

 - Distributional equity
 - Institutional feasibility
- Investment analysis of the PoA
 - Projection of penetration of technologies

□ Eligibility criteria

- In PoA-DD, establish the link between the policy and the CPA and demonstrate that CPA is not implemented without the policy PoA
- In CPA-DD, document the compliance with the EC

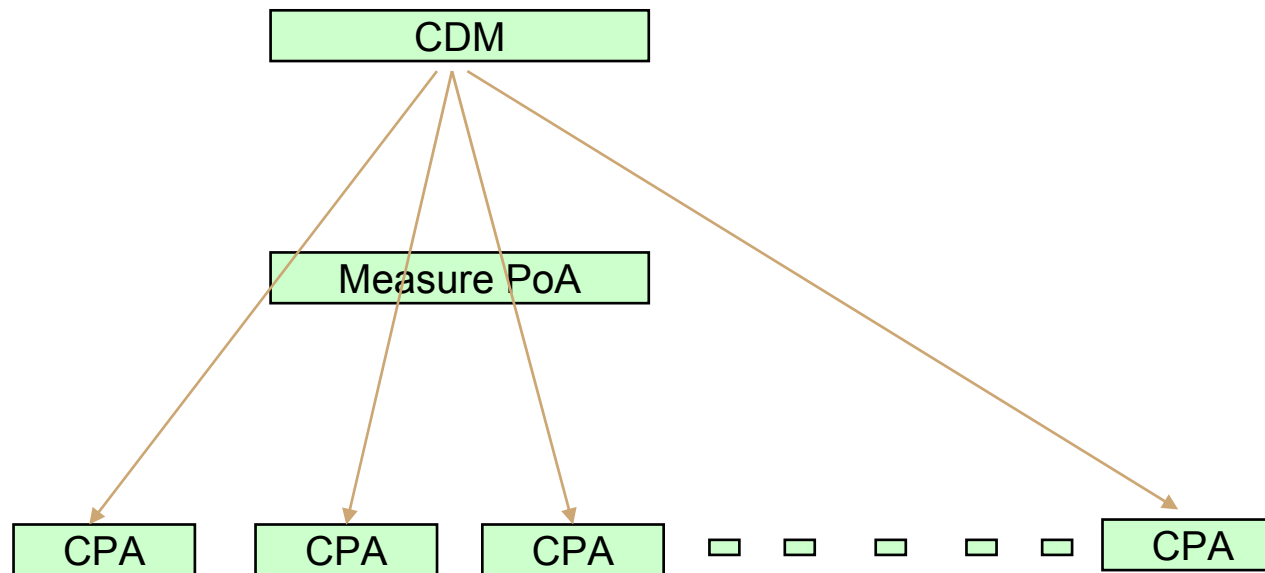


Policy PoAs

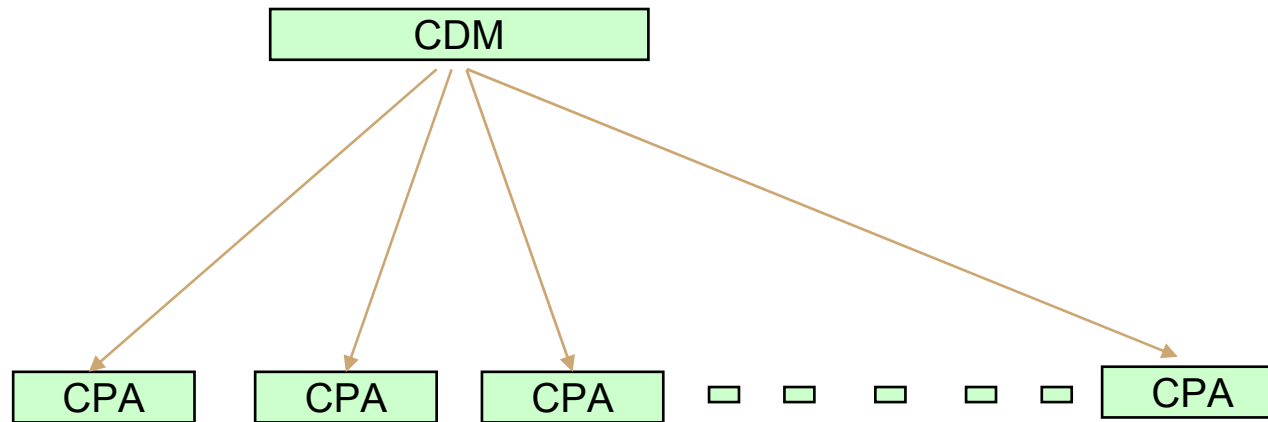
- (ii) Enforce an existing policy that is systematically not enforced; or
- (iii) Achieve an enhanced implementation of an existing policy.
 - When developing baseline scenario, take into account *Clarifications on the treatment of national and/or sectoral policies and regulations in determining a baseline scenario* (EB22, Annex 3)
- (i) Implement a new policy
 - Demonstrate that no similar policies have been implemented

Eligibility criteria

- In PoA-DD, demonstrate that CPA is not implemented without CDM
- In PoA-DD, establish conformity of EC ensures compliance with
 - Microscale additionality
 - Small scale additionality
 - Methodology requirements: LS, A/R, SSC A/R
- In CPA-DD, document the compliance with the EC



Recommendations from PoA workshop

- Define policy and measure PoAs and apply separate additionality approaches
- Allow barrier analysis for policy PoAs
- Allow investment analysis for policy PoAs
- Allow the current tools/guidelines for measure PoAs
