Re.: Post registration changes – Correction issues

Dear Mr. Tae-Sang Ha,

On behalf of the Chair of the CDM Executive Board (the Board), I would like to thank you for your letter of 12 November 2013 communicating your request for clarification on the post registration changes procedures of the CDM Program of Activities (PoA) 5019. Your letter has been made available to the Board.

Firstly I would like to clarify that any case-specific communication, regardless of its content, should be made only through the authorized project participant (PP), coordinating/managing entity (CME), the project focal point listed in the Modalities of Communication (MoC) form or by the project's designated operational entity (DOE).

With regards to your general questions I would like to clarify the two different tracks for post registration changes approval:

- (i) Post registration changes requiring prior approval by the Board, as described in paragraph 134 of the CDM Project Cycle Procedure (PCP): The request for prior approval shall be submitted following paragraph 140 of the PCP, by the DOE through a dedicated interface or by e-mail to the secretariat and shall be processed in accordance with the PCP paragraph 141.
- (ii) Post registration changes without prior approval by the Board, as described in paragraph 136 of the CDM Project Cycle Procedure (PCP): In this case the DOE that performs a verification of a registered CDM project activity or PoA shall submit the changes for acceptance by the Board as part of the request for issuance.

The request for post registration change for PoA 5019 was submitted in a separate communication and not as part of an issuance request. Therefore the request for post registration change followed the procedure requesting prior approval by the Board in accordance with paragraph 141 of the PCP.



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Finally, I would like to inform you that the appropriate channel for contacting the secretariat on issues related to the case-specific application of provisions contained in the PCP should be through e-mail to cdmregistration@unfccc.int by the authorized entity.
