Re.: Request of reconsideration by the CDM-EB of registration dates for the recently registered CDM project activities with registration numbers 9295, 9298, 9300 and 9302

Dear Mr. Nicoletti,

On behalf of the Chair of the CDM Executive Board (the Board), I would like to thank you for your letter of 30 September 2013 requesting a change to the effective registration date of the four CDM project activities 9295, 9298, 9300 and 9302. Your letter has been made available to the Board. It has been very carefully considered and I would now like to provide you with this response.

Please be informed that provisions pertaining to the effective registration date following revisions of the validation report and/or supporting documentation are contained in paragraph 98 of the clean development mechanism project cycle procedure (PCP), version 03.2. According to these provisions, the Board shall register each CDM project activity or PoA on the first working day subsequent to the finalization of the decision. The effective date of registration in such cases shall be the day on which the latest revisions to the validation report and/or supporting documentation were submitted.

For the aforementioned projects, a registration could only be achieved by submitting for each of them a revised documentation with additional information to demonstrate compliance with the applicable requirements. Without submission of the corrected documentation the project would not be in compliance with the current procedures, leading to a rejection. The effective registration date should therefore remain the date on which an updated validation report and/or supporting documentation were submitted, respectively 24, 21, 24 and 28 June 2013.
