Background: In accordance with paragraph 25 of the "Terms of reference of the support structure of the CDM Executive Board (version 04.0)", "members of a panel or working group shall abide by the code of conduct of the Board, as well as by the provisions related to conflict of interest and transparency of the Board, taking into account specific confidentiality requirements. They shall declare whether they have a pecuniary or financial interest in an issue presented to them as a member of the panel or working group and refrain from participating in any discussion or decision on the issue". Such issues include accreditation of operational entities, consideration and approval of methodologies, registration of clean development mechanism (CDM) project activities and/or the issuance of related certified emission reductions.

Agenda item 3.1.1. Standards for CDM project activities and programmes of activities

Background: The A/R WG, at its thirty-eighth meeting, considered the issues related to the inclusion of A/R CDM component project activities (CPAs) in A/R CDM programmes of activities (POAs) as presented by the secretariat and provided feedback to the secretariat in accordance with the request from the Board at EB 74. The A/R WG agreed

that the exceptions allowed for A/R project activities and PoAs should be maintained as indicated under paragraph 128(c) and footnote 18 of the CDM Project Standard, and also agreed to propose that the requirements for prior consideration of the CDM should be applied to A/R CPAs as is the case for normal A/R project activities. The agreed feedback was presented for the consideration of the Board at EB 75. The Board, at its seventy-fifth meeting, requested the A/R WG to provide additional inputs on rationale that would justify the continuation of exceptions allowed for A/R project activities and A/R PoAs as indicated in paragraph 128(c) and footnote 18 of the PS (version 04.0).
