- Difficulty in data monitoring and maintenance






Overview of PoA Status

- Total CDM / PoA projects registered 7,562 / 265
- Total CPAs included 2,566 (from 9 PoAs)
- Total CERs Issued for PoAs 871,000
- Popular sectors for PoA EE / Waste / Solar
- PoAs under Validation pipeline 124
- PoAs Rejected till 3


Overview of POA development


Overview of CDM and POA development

Multicounty PoA Guidelines and Updates

- CPAs can be added to a multicounty PoA project registered in another country.
- DNA clearance of all the participating country is required at the time of registration or geographical expansion (addition of country) is to be requested later on.
- Registration of single PoA with multi-technology (like wind, hydro, solar etc.) is allowed.
- Use of combination of methodologies for PoA registration is also allowed.
- During inclusion of a new CPA with new technology / methodology, complete validation process is to be done.
