Re.: Clarification for 2-year intimation of projects under validation

Dear Mr. Sah,

On behalf of the Chair of the CDM Executive Board, I would like to thank you for your letter of 13 November 2014 regarding clarification for 2-year intimation of projects under validation. Your letter has been made available to the CDM Executive Board (the Board).

I would like to inform you that, for a project activity with a start date on or after 2 August 2008 that unintentionally failed or delayed submission of the project progress, prior consideration of CDM is demonstrated with the initial notification within 180 days of the project start date and the communication between the project proponent, the secretariat and the host Party DNA<sup>1</sup>. However, I would like to draw your attention to the fact that even though the delay in submitting notifications of the project activity's progress<sup>2</sup> does not provide a reason for a negative validation opinion, the project participant(s) of a project activity must still submit such notifications.

I hope that this response has addressed your questions.
