Background

- The international carbon market is in a depressed situation, and CDM project developers have difficulties selling their CERs.
- □ We need a global climate neutral society by 2100 or earlier.

Action is needed!

Two new activities are underway:

- Encouraging voluntary use of CERs to offset the climate footprint of individuals, organizations and other stakeholders;
- 2. Developing an online platform to allow the general public to voluntarily cancel CERs (an online marketplace for CERs).

Voluntary cancellation of CERs...?

Voluntary cancellation = effective removal of a CER from further use or transfer.

- Why use voluntary cancellation?
 - Organizations or individuals wishing to show leadership by voluntarily compensating their emissions and supporting sustainable development;
 - Increase de facto mitigation (in particular by governments);
 - Support developing countries (transfer of finance, technology, capacity building, etc.);
 - Contribute to closing pre-2020 mitigation ambition gap;
 - Preserve investors' confidence in UNFCCC-mandated mechanisms.









- 1. To support CDM project developers by providing an additional channel to offer their CERs for sale (and cancellation) to the public.
- 2. To allow the public to support mitigation action (and sustainable development) in a voluntary manner.

Key characteristics of the platform



- Makes CERs available for voluntary cancellation (VC) easily visible and searchable;
- Contains a simple process to pay for the VC of those CERs;
- For each purchase a certificate will be issued to the buyer;
- No brokerage fee charged to any user;
- Only CERs located in the CDM registry will be offered (both CP1 and CP2).



General features

- a) UNFCCC operates the platform;
- b) PayPal or credit card fees (both methods possible);
- c) Accessible through the main internet browsers (Chrome, Internet Explorer, Firefox and Safari);
- d) Accessible from desktop and mobile devices;
- e) Initial version will be available in English. Possibility to add other languages later;
- f) Availability: 24 hours a day, seven days a week;
- g) Service-desk support during UNFCCC secretariat working hours.
