Re.: DOE selection for renewing the crediting period

Dear Ms. Nagai,

On behalf of the Chair of the CDM Executive Board, I would like to thank you for your communication of 15 September 2015 to the CDM Executive Board (the Board), regarding the selection of designated operational entity (DOE) for renewing the crediting period. Your communication has been made available to the Board in accordance with the relevant provision of the procedure for direct communication with stakeholders.¹

Please note that a DOE who wishes to perform validation for renewal of crediting period following a verification for the same large scale CDM project activity, shall submit a request for authorization to do so from the Board, in accordance with paragraph 294 of the CDM project cycle procedure (version 09.0).

Also, please note that the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), at its tenth session, through decision 4/CMP.10,² paragraph 14, requested the Board to analyse the implications, and possible provisions for ensuring environmental integrity, of allowing the same DOE to carry out validation and verification for the same project activity or programme of activities of all scales and report back on this matter to the CMP at its eleventh session for its consideration. Based on this request, the Board is currently reviewing the relevant rules in the existing regulatory documents.
