Re.: Request for Clarification on Monitoring and Verification in conflict zones

Dear Ms. Mikolajewski,

I would like to inform you that your communication of 6 November 2015 has been considered by the CDM Executive Board (the Board), at its eighty-seventh meeting as per paragraph 55 of the meeting report.

The Board agreed that in view of the security situation in the project region, the following contingency measures may be implemented for monitoring and verification of the programme of activities (ID: 5067) and project activity (ID: 2711) for a period of three years from the date of publication of the eighty-seventh meeting report of the Board (27 November 2015):

- a) The CME and DOE may apply a combination of survey and data collection methods as per section 9 of the "Guidelines for sampling and surveys for CDM project activities and programme of activities" (version 4.0, CDM-EB86-A04), for example using telephone interviews and household visits for the data collection;
- b) Joint site visits by the monitoring and verification personnel to collect data and evidence may be undertaken.
