### Agenda item 1. Agenda and meeting organization

#### Agenda item 1.1. Opening

1. **Action**: The Chair of the Methodologies Panel (MP) shall open the seventy-first meeting of the panel.

#### Agenda item 1.2. Adoption of the agenda

2. Action: The MP may wish to adopt the proposed agenda for the seventy-first meeting.

Background: The agenda was drawn up based on submission requests, workplan of the panel and working groups for 2016 and mandates from the Board.

### Agenda item 2. Governance and management matters

#### Agenda item 2.1. Membership issues

3. **Action:** Members of the MP may wish to <u>provide</u> statements on any potential conflict of interest concerning the issues on the agenda for the meeting, and take action, as appropriate.

Background: In accordance with paragraph 25 of the "Terms of reference of the support structure of the CDM Executive Board (version 04.0)" members of a panel or working group shall abide by the code of conduct of the Board. They shall declare whether they have a pecuniary or financial interest in an issue presented to them as a member of the panel or working group and refrain from participating in any discussion or decision on the issue.

Background: The secretariat will brief the MP on the status of top-down and bottom-up proposed standardized baselines. - 7. **Action:** The MP may wish to <u>take note</u> of the update on a) relevant editorial revisions, b) fast track clarifications, c) e-decisions and d) any other relevant regulatory matters finalized since the last meeting of the panel (MP 70).
  - (a) E-decision: Revision of "ACM0014: Treatment of wastewater", to standardize requirements related to additionality (MP leading, input from SSC WG);
  - (b) E-decision: Revision of fossil fuel cogeneration methodologies, incorporating the new flowchart: AM0048, AM0107, ACM 0026.

#### Agenda item 3.1. Standards/tools

- 11. ► Action: The MP may wish <u>finalize</u> the concept note on the development of standards with a methodological framework for specific project types (*joint MP / SSC WG*) for:
  - Energy-efficient appliances for residential application;

Background: The Board considered a concept note on the "Development of standards with a methodological framework for two specific project types for development of standardized baselines" and approved the identified sectors for development of standards for standardized baselines, i.e. energy-efficient appliances for residential application (e.g. air conditioners, refrigerators) and energy efficiency in buildings at EB 85 (EB 85, para. 39).

## Agenda item 3.1.1. Consideration of proposed and top down standardized baselines

12. ► Action: No proposed and top down standardized baselines are to be considered at this meeting.

Background: The proposed top-down standardized baselines are developed as part of the further development of the standardized baselines framework (EB 82 report, annex 6). The support to the top-down development of standardized baselines is based under core activities included in the approved workplan of panels and working groups for 2016 (EB 88 report, annex 2). ## Agenda item 3.1.2. Consideration of proposed new large scale methodologies and tools

  - (a) **NM0373:** "Introduction of a new district cooling system";
  - (b) **NM0374:** "Introduction of low resistivity wire or cable to new or existing power line";
  - (c) **NM0375:** "Gas insulated metal enclosed switchgear SF6 emission reduction measurement and monitoring methodology".

Background: New large-scale methodologies are developed based on submissions of proposed new methodologies, upon decision by the Board to develop a new methodology or as prompted by the CMP, or as suggested by a methodological panel or working group or the UNFCCC secretariat in accordance with the procedures "Development, revision and clarification of baseline and monitoring methodologies and methodological tools" (version 02.0). ## Agenda item 3.1.3. Consideration of revisions of large-scale methodologies and tools

  - (a) **ACM0001:** "Flaring or use of landfill gas", to include clarity on the applicable baseline and to improve the clarity of simplified additionality provisions;
  - (b) **ACM0017:** "Production of biodiesel for use as fuel" (*joint MP and SSC WG*);
  - (c) Methodological tool "Project and leakage emissions from biomass" (**TOOL 16**);
  - (d) Methodological tool "Tool to calculate the emission factor for an electricity system" (TOOL 07) to better accommodate small isolated grids in SIDS and LDCs and to enhance clarity of the requirements related to the demonstration of transmission constraints;
  - (e) Methodological tool "Investment analysis" (**TOOL 27**) to identify the host countries where the cost of equity may be calculated using the capital asset pricing model (CAPM) list of countriesand update the default values of ROE;
  - (f) "Combined tool to identify the baseline scenario and demonstrate additionality, based on a gap analysis to identify issue that it does not cover.

Background: Revisions of approved large-scale methodologies and tools are based on submissions of proposed revised methodologies or tools, upon decision by the Board to revise a methodology or a methodological tool or as prompted by the CMP, or as suggested by a methodological panel or working group or the UNFCCC secretariat in accordance with the procedure "Development, revision and clarification of baseline and monitoring methodologies and methodological tools" (version 0.2). Background: This work is based on a mandate given by the Board in its eighty-sixth meeting (EB 86 report, paras. 36, 38 and 39), is included in the approved workplan for panels and working groups for 2016 (EB 88, Annex 3) and the workplan of project "Development of new methodologies to broaden the applicability of the CDM" (EB 82 report, annex 7).
