Reason for cancellation

GMR Hyderabad International Airport Ltd., (GHIAL) is responsible for operation, management and development of Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA), Shamshabad, India. GHIAL is fully committed for climate change mitigation and to ensure sustainable development of RGIA. Since 2012, RGIA has been participating in Airport Council International's (ACI) Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme for greenhouse gas emissions management. RGIA achieved "Level-2 : Reduction" in 2012 and Level 3 : Optimization in 2013 under this Programme. To further upgrade and achieve the highest accreditation level under this Programme, GHIAL has decided to offset its Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (staff business travel) emissions for the year 2015, by purchasing 25783 Certified Emission Reductions (equivalent to 25783 tons of CO₂). By offsetting the Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (Staff business travel) emissions, RGIA will achieve the requirements of the Carbon Neutrality (Level 3+) of ACI Airport carbon Accreditation Programme.
