Reason for cancellation

Bangalore International Airport Ltd., (BIAL) is responsible for operation, management and development of Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru(KIAB), Devanahalli, Karnataka State, India. BIAL is fully committed for climate change mitigation and to ensure sustainable development of KIAB. Since 2011, BIAL has been participating in Airport Council International's (ACI) Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme for greenhouse gas emissions management. KIAB achieved "Level-2: Reduction" in 2012 and "Level 3: Optimization" in 2013 under this Programme. To further upgrade and achieve the highest accreditation level under this Programme, BIAL has decided to offset its Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (staff business travel) emissions for the year 2016, by purchasing 40000 Certified Emission Reductions (equivalent to 40000 tons of CO2). By offsetting the Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (Staff business travel) emissions, KIAB will achieve the requirements of the Carbon Neutrality (Level 3+) of ACI Airport carbon Accreditation Programme.
