#### Overview of outcomes of SB46 / APA1.3 (May 2017)

- The objective to expedite work relating to the Paris Agreement to match the rapid enter into force and to advance other ongoing work was met.
- Under the Paris Agreement Work programme, Parties agreed on intersessional work including submissions and presessional events.
- Coordination amongst bodies and approaches and awareness of linkages between issues were further enhanced.
- Events organized at the May sessions contributed to building capacity of negotiators, deepening understanding of issues and framing conclusions.
- Presessional events of all PAWP work are scheduled for 4-5 November 2017.



### APA - what to achieve in November?

- Use the submissions, the non-papers and the "round tables" on almost all items to advance the negotiations
- Move forward, keeping in mind the deadline of December 2018, in
  - Transitioning from concepts to focused technical discussions
  - Resolving the remaining divergences of views, as possible
  - Formulating structured elements of text and textual proposals
- Determine the way forward in 2018 (under the COP guidance)




# SBSTA 47 – objectives




## **SBI:** what to achieve in November?
